of Rhode Island formerly in consideration of the sum
of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Catherine
Swalley of said Norwich single woman the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge have received thereof & for her
quit claimed & do by these presents renounce & forever
quit claim unto her the said Catherine Swalley her
heirs & assigns for ever two certain lots of land one being
called the house lot & the other called a wood lot marked
on the Plat Number two & drawn in right of Stephen
Swalley as marked on the Plat will more fully appears
of the donation of the Estate of John Swalley deceased
to me bounded as follows the house lot is bounded northerly
& easterly & southerly on lot number one drawn in
right of Margaret Thompson & uniting on the County
& Granter's survey with road, together with the house &
other buildings thereon standing, the wood lot is bounded
on follows northerly on lot number three drawn in
right of many Swalley easterly on land of Robert Williams
Swalley southerly on land of John & motel uniting
on the Granter's road, for a further description of said
lots reference is to be had to the Plat as above said
and of Anna Swalley wife of the above said Stephen
Swalley for the consideration paid to my husband as
above said do nothing at all my right of dower &
power of third in the Premises as above described
do have & to hold the above described Premises together
with all the premises & appurtenances thereto belonging
to her the said Catherine Swalley her heirs & assigns forever
