

This indenture lease made the twen-
tyeth day of July 1558. Between first
Shert John Sewalley of Warwick
in the County of Kent and State
of Rhodislane yeoman of five
years Rented for the term of five
years from the first day of April
one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty Eight to John Sewalley
and William Sewalley both of
Warwick and Josiah Sewalley of
Leventing all of the County and
State aforesaid yeoman all the
farm in said Warwick or which
he now reside that he hold by lease
from my John Sewalley for ~~the~~
and Deley Sewalley except three
quarters of an acre which he save
for green pasture

The said John Sewalley for William
Sewalley and Josiah Sewalley are
to do all the labours and have farm
one acre to deliver to the said
John Sewalley one half part of
all the produce that arise on
said farm in the field of each
of the five years of the said John
Sewalley to pay half the taxes
and the John Sewalley for William
Sewalley and Josiah Sewalley to pay
the other half
and the said John William and
Josiah are not to commit no
waste of timber or any other
thing and covenanted with said
farm

From to the said John Sewdley
at the expiration of the year
years from the first day of April
1788 in as good order as they
received it which is to be on the
first day of April 1788 for
the sum of one of the said
parties have set our hands and
affix our seals the day and year
