in the County of Kent and Colony above said, and the said Land in the
name which was given me by my Grandfather Peter Lovelley by his ex-
-test Mill and Iffhamout and said land being part of his home steap farm
which farm being (N.Y.) of the first Division of the said manor land, lies
Laid out to the Right of George Egot, as by Plot containing by estimation
Thirty acres, and is butted and bounded as followseth West & North on
Land of the said Michael Lovelley, Leftly on said Michael Lovelley,
Southly on Land of Phillip Greene, and westly on Land of Nott,
Foxborn, with all the privileges, profits, commodities and appurtenances
whatsoever to the said Land belonging or any ways appertaining to him
