the United States of America, Annoq. Domini. 1786.

THE Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the said *Peter*
Levalley his Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, shall pay unto the
said *Joseph Clarke* or his Successor in said Office, the
Sum of *three Pounds Eight Shillings* in Lawful Money Bills of said State,
or in Silver or Gold equivalent, as aforesaid, at or before the *Twentieth* Day
of *October* A. D. *1792* then this Obligation shall be void, and said Sum
shall discharge One Year's Interest of the principal Sum of a Mortgage, bearing
equal Date herewith; but upon Failure, shall be in full Force.
