in or to the above premises.

To have and to hold the aforesaid premises
unto the said John Lunsley, to the only use & behoof
of the said John Lunsley, during his natural life,
so that neither we Edw Lunsley & John Lunsley Junr
and both Lunsley, nor our heirs nor Heirs should
not have any demand on the lease for the rents and
profits of the above premises, but by these presents sheweth
