KNOW all Men by these Presents, That I *Peter Levalley* in the
of *Warwick* in the County of *Kent* in the
State of Rhode-Island, &c. *Mayor* am holden and obligated unto
Joseph Clarke General Treasurer
of said State, in the Sum of *Six* Pounds *Seven Shillings*
in Lawful Money Bills of said State, or in Silver or Gold equivalent, to
be paid to said *Joseph Clarke* or his Successor in said Office:
For which Payment I bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, firmly
by these Presents. Sealed with my Seal, dated the *Twenty Eight* Day of
October in the *Eleventh* Year of the Independence of
the United States of America, Annoq. Domini, 1786.

THE Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the said *Peter*
his Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, shall pay unto the
said *Joseph Clarke* or his Successor in said Office, the
Sum of *Three Pounds Eight Shillings* in Lawful Money Bills of said State,
or in Silver or Gold equivalent, as aforesaid, at or before the *Twenty Eight* Day
of *October* A. D. *1793* then this Obligation shall be void, and said Sum
shall discharge One Year's Interest of the principal Sum of a Mortgage, bearing
equal Date herewith; but upon Failure, shall be in full Force.
