For which Payment I bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, firm-
ly by these Presents. Sealed with my Seal, dated the *Twenty eight* Day of
October - in the *Eleventh* - Year of the Independence of
the United States of America, Annoq. Domini, 1786.

THE Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the said *Peter*
Levalley his Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, shall pay unto the
said *Thos. Munniceil* or his Successor in said Office, the
Sum of *Twelve Dollars* *Five Shillings* in Lawful Money Bills of said State,
or in Silver or Gold equivalent, as aforesaid, at or before the *Twenty eight* Day
of *October* - A. D. 1799 then this Obligation shall be void, and said Sum
shall discharge One Seventh Part of the principal Sum of a Mortgage, bearing
equal Date herewith; but upon Failure, shall be in full Force.
