Portraits will meaningfully depict the image and personality of the subject.







## Our Elders worry about loneliness, isolation, being ignored...

Let's think small, personal, human scale, and relationship-focused, in a safe environment! Elderhouse is an alternative to institutionalized settings. Elderhouse is purposely designed to resemble a single family experience; it is small enough to fit in on a single family street; it is a shared home balancing privacy with social connection. Its focus is health and wellbeing. It's smaller size encourages companionship and belonging... because loneliness and isolation contribute to failing health. In practical terms, staffing consists of in-house caregiving management supplemented by Alberta Health Homecare professionals.

Elderhouse's operational plan includes the flexibility to transition to higher levels of care (short of complex medical needs). To date JLF has received interest in and requests for the Elderhouse model of care.
