



MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION

Hoo's Woods Raptor Center is a non-profit 501c3 organization founded in 1998 by Dianne Moller. Hoo's Woods continues to be a valuable resource of education concerning raptors and conservation locally, regionally, nationally and internationally. The center is dedicated to the education and rehabilitation of birds of prey species, including eagles, hawks, falcons, owls, and vultures.

Eligibility: The funds for this matching grant are sponsored by We Energies Foundation , Antonia Foundation, Eco Lab Foundation and Natural Resources Foundation are limited annually. To be eligible for these funds, which are designed to help offset a Hoo's Woods educational program, applicants must be of a school group, scout group, after-school program, senior group, nature-specific group, or conservation/environmental group, and must be located in Wisconsin. Programs are one-hour in length and must be booked and conducted before June 1, 2019. Additional fees for mileage may apply.
