ORCA LIFT PROGRAM INFORMATION

Starting April 1, 2023 Pierce Transit joins regional transit partners in offering the ORCA LIFT program to our riders.

ORCA LIFT is a reduced adult fare program available for those that meet the income eligibility requirements which are up to, or equal to, 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines. Customers who are eligible can learn more about program guidelines and how to apply by visiting info.tdycorca.com/LIFT.

- Operators should note that these reduced fares are offered strictly through use of ORCA LIFT cards; no ORCA LIFT fares may be paid using cash or mobile ticketing.
- Pierce Transit will accept ORCA LIFT on bus and runner services. To support information sharing as we roll out the program, Bus Safety and Training has updated the fare type training documents.
- A message is posted on our internal monitors and Schedulers will be conducting Operator outreach the first week of April to speak with those who may have missed the training and/or information.

To help eligible customers access this benefit, Pierce Transit has partnered with King County Public Health and Sound Transit to conduct ORCA LIFT outreach and enrollment at The Bus Shop at TDS. The enrollment eligibility process will be performed on site with representatives from these services.



Pre/Relief/Post Trip Inspection Overview:
All Operators must perform three (3) types of inspections using ZONAR:

- Pre-Trip Inspection
- Relief Inspections
- Post-Trip Inspection

Pre/Post/Relief inspections must be conducted using ZONAR to:

- Prevent accidents caused by vehicle deficiencies
- Ensure the vehicle is in safe operating condition
- Prevent loss to persons and property
- Assure vehicle does not contain unexpected riders and/or hazardous items
- Meet regulatory requirements of US DOT

WHY THE UNION JACK IS BACK AND HERE TO STAY

NORFOLK (June 4, 2019)

For the first time in nearly 17 years, the Navy's commissioned ships worldwide hoisted on their bows the star-spangled Union Jack during Tuesday's morning colors.

It was a moment of profound symbolism, pointing both to the Navy's heroic past and a potentially violent future.

Tuesday marked the 77th anniversary of the Battle of Midway, and it was the Union Jack that fluttered in ports during the island hopping campaign. Its rebirth on warships also has much to do with a call by Chief of Naval Operations Adm. John Richardson to focus on combat at sea against peer and near-peer competitors after nearly two decades of waging war against insurgencies and terrorist networks in the Middle East, Africa and Asia.
