The Science

Each essential oil has a unique set of chemical components that give the oil specific benefits. For example, some essential oils contain chemical constituents that make the oil useful for improving the appearance of the skin, while other oils have properties that might make it useful for repelling insects or supporting a restful sleep. An essential oil can have a combination of several different chemical components, giving each oil a diverse set of possible benefits.

While many essential oils contain cleansing chemical components, the most beneficial oils for cleaning are those with a high concentration of cleansing chemical constituents. The unique combination of chemical constituents in any essential oil will depend on what kind of plant it comes from—each plant produces a different essential oil with its own set of chemical components and thus, its own set of benefits. Because some essential oils will have a higher percentage of chemical components with cleansing benefits than others, these oils are more effective for household cleaning.

Let's take a look at some of the chemical constituents that have cleansing properties, and which essential oils contain high concentrations of these chemical components.

How Can I Make My Own Natural Cleaner?

Fortunately, there are many ways to clean surfaces in your home without using harsh chemicals. Cleaning with natural, non-toxic cleaners is healthier for the environment and everyone in it.

Baking soda, white vinegar and castile soap are three basics for nontoxic household cleaning.

BAKING SODA:

- Benefit: Absorbs and eliminates odour.
- Use as: Non-abrasive cleanser to clean countertops, sinks, and tubs.
- How to: Sprinkle some baking soda on carpet and vacuum after 15 minutes for a fresher look and feel. For scent, add a drop or two of lavender to the baking soda.

WHITE VINEGAR:

- Benefit: Contains natural antifungal and antibacterial properties that cut grease and dissolve mineral deposits.
- **Use as:** Cleanser for coffee maker, floors, refrigerator and so much more! (NOTE: Do not use on marble. Test a small area of your countertops before using)
- How to: Add some white vinegar to your spray cleaners for an extra punch. Use half vinegar to half water to clean out your coffee maker.

CASTILE SOAP:

- Benefit: Lifts dirt, cuts grease, and eliminates tough stains.
- How to: Pour a small amount over baking sheets and pans then scrub for a few minutes for clean, shiny results. You can use this to make your own detergent, foaming hand soap and more.

Fridge & Microwave Cleaner

Cleaning the fridge and microwave can be two of the most difficult chores around the house. Caked-on food, mystery stains, and questionable smells can make this a dreaded cleaning job that gets put off until the last minute. If you need a little help, try this DIY Refrigerator and Microwave Cleaner featuring Lemon essential oil for an easy cleaning job and refreshing aroma.

Ingredients

1 cup white vinegar2 cups hot water15 drops Lemon oil

Instructions

- 1. Combine the ingredients in glass spray bottle.
- 2. Spray mixture inside fridge or microwave, then scrub and wipe using damp cloth.



Stove Top Cleaner

Ingredients:

½ cup baking soda ½ cup table salt 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar 2 tablespoons water 4–5 drops of Purify Cleansing Blend

Directions:

- 1. Stir all ingredients together until they form a paste and spread it over the stove top and burners.
- 2. Leave it on for 15 minutes or longer for hard-to-remove stains.
 - 3. Using a sponge, scrub the mixture into the grime.
 - 4. Remove excess cleaner and wipe surface clean.



QUICK TIP

Before you go to bed pop a drop of lemon oil in your sink and a couple of drops on your tea towel. Your kitchen will smell divine in the morning!

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Dishwasher Tabs

Instead of using store-bought dishwasher detergent, you can make your own detergent pods with essential oils and an extra boost from the proprietary dōTERRA On Guard® formula

Ingredients

1 cup baking soda 1/4 cup citric acid

1 tablespoon dōTERRA On Guard® Cleaner Concentrate 5 drops Grapefruit oil Silicone moulds

Directions

- 1. Put baking soda, citric acid, dōTERRA On Guard Cleaner Concentrate, and Grapefruit oil in a mixing bowl. Mix together until the mixture is an even consistency.
- 2. Place in silicone moulds and let sit for four hours. Remove tabs.
 - 3. Store in an airtight container.
- 4. Use in dishwasher in place of store-bought dishwasher tablets (one at a time)



Deep Clean Scrub

Ingredients

1/2 cup of baking soda
1/3 cup of natural liquid dish soap
1/4 cup of hydrogen peroxide
3/4 cup of distilled water
30 drops of eucalyptus essential oil

Instructions

Mix together in squeeze bottle. Squirt in toilet, shower, or other dirty crevices. Scrub with brush.

Let stand for 20 minutes. Rinse.

Kitchen Degreaser

Ingredients

1 cup white vinegar

1/4 cup dish soap

10 drops lemon essential oil

Instructions

Mix all ingredients together in a spray bottle and shake well. Spray on kitchen countertops, stovetops, ovens or anywhere else you need to cut through grease.

Dishwashing Detergent

Ingredients

2 cups unscented castile soap20 drops Lime oil 8 drops Lemon oil6 drops Grapefruit or Wild Orange oil

Instructions

1. Fill a large, clean bottle with castile soap Note:
Dilute according to instructions if using a
concentrate

2. Add essential oils

3. To use, shake and add 1–2 tablespoons to dish water

Disinfectant

In a 4 oz bottle of distilled water, add 5 drops lavender, 2 drops wild orange, and 5 drops Melaleuca (or tea tree) essential oil. Another option: 15 drops Protective Blend.

Use to disinfect hands, counters, doorknobs, toilet seats, and more. Shake well before each use.

Oven Cleaner Spray

Ingredients

½ cup liquid soap 1 cup baking soda

½ cup hydrogen peroxide

2 tablespoon white vinegar [additional vinegar for rinse]
 10 drops of lemon essential oil
 10 drops of tea tree oil [optional]

Some helpful items: a spatula for scraping, gloves to protect your hands

Instructions

- 1. Empty everything out of the oven including the racks.
 - 2. Wipe the oven down with hot, soapy water.
 - 3. Mix together all the ingredients to make a paste.
- 4. Spread the paste all over the inside of the oven except on the heating elements.
- 5. Let it sit for at least 4 hours; the longer you let it sit, the more it can work. You can leave it on overnight and it won't hurt anything.
 - 6. Remove the paste with a rag, brush, or scrub sponge.
- 7. You can do a final rinse with a mixture of ½ vinegar and ½ water in a spray bottle.



Refresher Pods

With all the different food items, it's only natural to have a smelly fridge, right? Well, not anymore! These easy to make fridge refreshers are a simple way to deodorize your refrigerator without the use of toxic cleaners. Just place one refresher in your fridge each month for a fresh and clean scent every time you open up your fridge. Now, there is no excuse for having a smelly fridge!

Ingredients

2.5 cups baking soda
1/2 - 1 cup water
15 drops Purify essential oil
Silicone mould

Directions

Combine baking soda, 1/2 cup water, and essential oils into bowl. Stir together. If needed, add more water until thick paste forms. The mixture should resemble damp sand. Divide mixture equally into silicone mould. Allow it to rest 2-3 days or until mixture hardens. Once hard, place in refrigerator to help eliminate unpleasant odours. Store additional fridge refreshers in an airtight container until ready to use. One disk will last up to a month.

Cleaning the bathroom is not an experience people look forward to very often. Being stuck in a small, enclosed space with harsh chemicals not only makes it hard to breathe, but can also be hazardous to your health.

The next time you clean your bathroom, why not try mixing up an effective cleaner with many ingredients you already have at home? It still might not be your favourite household chore, but you will at least have a clean bathroom and cleaning products that make the job a little easier to handle.

Make in small batches and store in an airtight container. This is enough for two to four applications. This soft scrub is excellent for getting rid of soap scum, removing stains, and brightening your tub, tile, and toilet. To use, just apply and let it sit for 5–10 minutes and then scrub. Once done scrubbing, take a wet cloth and wipe clean. Note: this scrub is also great to use when cleaning your kitchen sink or refrigerator.

Soft Cleaning Scrub

Ingredients

¾ rounded cup baking soda ¼ cup unscented liquid castile soap 1 tablespoon water 1 tablespoon vinegar 5–10 drops Lemon oil

Instructions

- 1. In bowl, combine baking soda and castile soap.
 - 2. Add water and stir.
- 3. Add vinegar and essential oil. The consistency should be a soft paste.
 - 4. Store in airtight container.



Glass Cleaner

Ingredients

16-ounce spray bottle
1½ cup white vinegar
½ cup distilled water
8 drops of your citrus oil of choice
Recommended oils: Lemon, Lime,
Grapefruit, Wild Orange, and Citrus Bliss®.

Instructions

- 1. Add vinegar, water, and essential oil(s) to spray bottle and shake.
 - 2. Clean surfaces.

QUICK TIP

Add a drop or two of your favourite essential oil to the inside of your toilet paper roll. Each time it is touched the aroma abounds leaving your bathroom smelling clean and fresh.

Try Lemon, Lime, Geranium, Green Mandarin

Deep Toilet Scrub

Ingredients

1/2 cup baking soda
1/3 cup liquid dishwashing soap
1/4 cup hydrogen peroxide
30 drops eucalyptus essential oil
3/4 cup water

Instructions

Mix together in a squeeze-type bottle, then squirt into toilet. Scrub and let stand 20 minutes.

Daily Shower Spray

Ingredients

1.5 cups water
1 cup white vinegar
1/2 cup rubbing alcohol
1 teaspoon natural liquid dish soap (not castile soap)

15 drops lime essential oil 15 drops melaleuca (tea tree) essential oil

Instructions

Combine in a quart-sized spray bottle. Spray daily on shower door and walls after use (this is a preventative spray, designed to help prevent build-up)

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Toilet Pods

For an even easier way to clean the toilet, consider making your own toilet cleaning pods that you can simply drop in the toilet when you are ready for a clean, refreshed toilet and bathroom.

Ingredients

1 cup baking soda½ cup citric acid

1½ tablespoon unscented castile soap
15 drops essential oil (try Lime, Melaleuca,
Siberian Fir, Lemon, Cilantro, or a
combination of any of these oils)
Silicone mould

Instructions

- 1. Stir the baking soda and citric acid together until combined.
- 2. Slowly stir in the castile soap and essential oils. Stir until the mixture resembles wet sand.
- 3. Pack the pod mixture into a mould and let dry at least four hours. If the mixture expands above the mould, firmly press back down.
- 4. Once dry, remove the pods from the mould and store in an airtight container.
- 5. To use, simply drop one into the toilet, wait until the pod stops bubbling, and start scrubbing.



Antibacterial Cleaner

Ingredients

2 cups baking soda 15 drops lemon essential oil 15 drops tea tree (melaleuca) oil White vinegar

Instructions

Mix together the baking soda and essential oils and store in a Mason jar. When ready to use, sprinkle some in your sink, bathtub or toilet and spray with white vinegar (you could also spray the baking soda mixture with your homemade all-purpose cleaner). Allow the baking soda to foam up for about a minute and then wipe or scrub clean with a wet cloth or a toilet scrubber. Rinse any remaining residue down the toilet or drain.

QUICK TIP

Place a diffuser with intermittent settings in your bathroom. Perfect deodoriser!

Spot Stain Remover

Ingredients

oil
White vinegar

Directions

Place essential oil in a 10ml roller bottle and top with white vinegar. Apply to spot stain area and soak for an hour before washing as usual.



On Guard Cleaner Concentrate applied directly to larger or more stubborn stains works brilliantly! Simply dab or spray on and let sit for an hour or so before washing.









Linen Spray

Ingredients

1 cup rubbing alcohol
2 cups distilled water
15 drops dōTERRA Lemon
15 drops dōTERRA Siberian Fir

Instructions

Combine all iingredients in a 250mL Glass Spray Bottle.
Use within two weeks.

QUICK TIPS

- Add two to three drops of Wild Orange oil to dryer sheets to add a refreshing aroma to your laundry.
- Add a few drops of Siberian Fir oil to the rinse cycle to help get rid of unpleasant odours.
 - Add a drop of your favourite essential oil to a damp cloth and place on top of clothing when ironing.
- Add a few drops of Lavender to dryer sheets and throw in the dryer with some towels for a luxurious, relaxing aroma the next time you get out of the shower.
- Add ½ cup of white vinegar and four to six drops of Melaleuca essential oil to the wash cycle to naturally brighten your white clothes.

Fabric Softener

Ingredients

2 cups white vinegar
2 tbsp bi-carb soda
2 cups hot water
15 drops dōTERRA essential oil

Combo 1: "Super Clean" dōTERRA Eucalyptus & Tea Tree

Combo 2: "Citrus Burst" dōTERRA Lemongrass, Lemon & Wild Orange

Combo 3: "Crisp and Fresh" dōTERRA Siberian Fir & Purify

Instructions

Mix in a large bowl or jug due the frothing reaction between bi-carb and vinegar. Once settled pour into a glass bottle and shake before each use. Add two tablespoons when required to your wash. Use within two weeks.



QUICK TIP

Add clean citrus rinds to your storage bottle or jar for some extra oomph!



Pot Pouri Freshener

Ingredients

½ cup baking soda 5–6 drops favourite essential oil

Instructions

Please all ingredients in glass jar and cover with thin mesh or stocking or a lid with holes

Recommended essential oils: doTERRA Balance®, Cassia, Geranium, Eucalyptus, Lavender, Lemon, doTERRA On Guard®, Purify, or Wild Orange.

Air Freshener Spray

Ingredients

20 drops Lemon oil 20 drops Grapefruit oil 20 drops Lime oil 1 Tablespoon Witch Hazel or Vodka Distilled water

Instructions

- 1. In a glass spray bottle, add Witch Hazel or Vodka, essential oils and top with water. Depending on the size of the spray bottle, you may wish to add more essential oils.
 - 2. To refresh a room, shake the bottle well, and spray liberally.



Ingredients

1/2 cup of olive oil 10 drops of lemon essential oil

Instructions

Use dry, clean rag to spot-polish leather and wood furniture.

Always spot test prior to use.

Wood Polish

Ingredients

½ cup olive oil

½ cup vinegar

10 drops doTERRA essential oils

Recommended oils: Wild Orange,

Arborvitae, or Lemon.

Instructions

Place ingredients into spray bottle, apply and polish



Pine Floor Cleaner

Ingredients

1 bucket of water
2 tablespoon liquid castile soap
5 drops Douglas Fir essential oil
5 drops Siberian Fir essential oil
5 drops Cypress essential oil
10 drops Lemon essential oil

Instructions

Add soap and essential oils to bucket of warm water. Dip mop or rag in bucket and clean tile or linoleum floors. You can also use this same recipe as a countertop cleaning spray.

Carpet Cleaner

Ingredients

2 cups baking soda 10 drops essential oils (recommended oils: Lavender, Lemon, Cypress, or Eucalyptus)

Instructions

- 1. Add essential oil to baking soda and stir until well combined.
 - 2. Sprinkle mixture over carpet.
- 3. Let rest one to two hours. Vacuum.
- 4. Store remaining baking soda in an airtight container for future use.


Mould & Mildew Spray

Ingredients

1 glass spray bottle
2 c white vinegar
10 drops doTERRA Tea Tree
Essential Oil
10 drops doTERRA Wild Orange
Essential Oil
10 drops doTERRA Clove Essential
Oil
5 drop doTERRA Oregano Essential

Instructions

- 1. Mix all ingredients together and shake well before use.
- 2. Spray over affected area and leave to soak for about 5–10 minutes. If able. Rinse well with water, or wipe clean with a damp cloth. Dry the area thoroughly.
- 3. NOTE: This is NOT recommended to use on stone or granite benches as the vinegar may cause some damage over time. If using on grout, make sure to rinse really well with clean water.



QUICK TIP

Mould around the house is not only unsightly but it can also have adverse effects on our health. Symptoms caused by mould allergy may include:

- Respiratory illness or asthma;
 - Watery, itchy, red eyes;
 - Chronic cough;
 - Headaches or migraines;
 - Rashes (dermatitis);
 - Tiredness:
- Sinus problems, blocked nose; and
 - Frequent sneezing;

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Cleaning Wipes

Ingredients

1 roll premium paper towels
2 cups warm water
2 tablespoon dōTERRA Fractionated
Coconut Oil
3 drops dōTERRA OnGuard®
3 drops dōTERRA Lemon
1-2 tablespoons dōTERRA OnGuard ®
Foaming Hand Wash

Instructions

Cut roll of paper towels in half – one half now other half for later. Place one half of paper towels in an air tight container. In a bowl combine all above ingredients. Pour mixture over paper towels and let absorb. Remove carboard tube. Pull wipes from centre when ready.



Reusable Dust

Wipes

Ingredients

2 cups distilled water
25 drops Lemon oil
2 tablespoons olive oil
1 tablespoon white vinegar

Instructions

- 1. Cut 3–5 flour cloth towels into fourths or quarters.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine all ingredients and add all cloths.
- 3. Soak in liquid mixture until there are no dry spots on the cloth.
- 4. Ring out each cloth until it is damp and no more moisture comes out.
- 5. Tightly roll up the cloths and store them together in an air-tight container.
 - 6. If cloths happen to dry out before you use them, dampen with water before use.

Tip: To reuse simply wash used cloths and re-apply ingredients.



All Purpose Spray

Ingredients

½ cup white vinegar

1¾ cups water

30 drops doTERRA essential oils

Recommended essential oil combinations:

- 15 drops each of Lavender and Lemon
- 10 drops each of Eucalyptus, Peppermint, and Wild Orange
 - 30 drops doTERRA On Guard®
- 15 drops each of Grapefruit and doTERRA On Guard



Window Cleaner

Ingredients

½ cup white vinegar
½ cup rubbing alcohol
10 drops Lemon
1 Tbsp Cornstarch or arrowroot powder

Instructions

Miz all ingredients together in a glass spray bottle
Shake, spray and wipe clean



Mattress Dust Mite Solution

Create a sprinkle jar of 1 cup baking soda + 5 drops Melaleuca (tea tree oil) and sprinkle on the bare mattress. Open you windows and leave for 2 hrs before vacuuming it up.

Studies have shown that pure melaleuca oil (only use @doterra because store bought won't work) immobilized 100% of dust mites after 30 min and killed them all after 2 hrs $\Box\Box$



Cleaning Your Diffuser

- 1. Turn off your diffuser.
- 2. Fill the water reservoir halfway to the line with hot water.
- 3. Turn the diffuser on and let it run for three to five minutes, allowing the hot water to disperse throughout.


