

Water That Connects Us: God's living water!

and handicapped residents across four local sites, and 7 schools. Every Sunday, our dedicated water team continues to reach those aged 70 and older.

Thanks to your support, we're not just quenching thirst—we're preserving dignity within a very vulnerable population.

### **Water With Dignity: A Lifeline for the Elderly**

Twice a week, our water team faithfully serves the elderly and physically challenged members of our community – many of whom are unable to fetch water on their own.

The process begins with care: our team visits each participant's home to pick up their empty jugs, washes them thoroughly, and transports them to *Puits de Jacob*, our trusted clean water provider. Once filled, the team returns the jugs directly to each home, ensuring access to safe, drinkable water for the week. The access to this basic need helps restore dignity and relieve burdens for some of our most vulnerable members in the community.

We are especially grateful for our three-wheel motorbike, which makes it possible to reach even the most remote areas of Côtes-de-Fer. Without it, many of these deliveries simply wouldn't be possible.

Because of your support, our elders are seen, cared for, and loved.

Out of our **7 partner schools**, **5 still lack hygiene facilities**. We've also received **8 new school applications** for our health and hygiene program.

Though we planned to add just 3 new schools per year, the growing interest and urgent needs are showing us that **God is expanding our vision**. Our dream is to see the **Grandma Martha School Health Program** in **every school across Haiti – and beyond**.

### **Caring With Dignity: Home Visits That Heal More Than the Body**

In April alone, our compassionate home health nurses — Miss Gertrude and Miss Veronica— completed an incredible 430 home visits across the Côtes-de-Fer area. During these visits. The visits consist of more than just check vital signs. They brought care, conversation, and connection to elderly individuals who are often isolated and overlooked.

Each visit includes physical assessments, blood pressure and glucose monitoring, wellness checks, and when needed, medication support or referrals to local clinics. But just as important, our nurses take the time to sit, to listen, and to pray with them — reminding each person that they are seen, valued, and deeply loved.

In many of these homes, our nurses are usually the only visitors some of our elderly receive during the week. For those who can no longer cook or care for themselves, we've begun offering laundry kits and hygiene support a few years ago. For the month of April, we distributed 88 of these kits to help maintain cleanliness and comfort with dignity.
