Class Description:

What makes a cookbook truly good? Is it the recipes, the stories, or the people behind them?

In this hands-on culinary and literacy-based course, students step into the role of test kitchen chefs, food critics, and storytellers as they work together to create a True North Community Cookbook. Through tasting, testing, and documenting recipes, students will explore how food can reflect the heart of a community.

Students will:

- Test and refine recipes to ensure clarity and quality
- Collect and include meaningful family recipes (tested and untested)
- Write thoughtful reviews and reflections on dishes
- Learn how cookbooks are organized, written, and shared

As part of our Hoosier Food Experience, students will discover how local ingredients, traditions, and flavors help tell the story of where we live. Together, we will answer the driving question: How can we, as culinary students, use food to tell the story of our community?

This course blends cooking, writing, collaboration, and creativity—giving students a meaningful role in producing something lasting that can be shared with families and the broader community.

On week 12, students will be asked to stay after classes for the cookbook launch.

Students will:

- Select and prepare a small sample of an Indiana-inspired dish

- Explain how their chosen dish represents the people and culture of Indiana
- Present and engage with visitors during the Hoosier Museum class experience during Week 11

As visitors explore and interact, they will have the opportunity to taste, learn, and vote on their favorite dishes—helping determine which recipes will be featured in the True North Community Cookbook.

Each week, readers will dive into engaging texts, analyze characters and plot twists, and participate in lively debates and discussions about the choices, challenges, and “what ifs” within these unique worlds.

Families will receive a Google Form to review the proposed books for the syllabus, allowing parents to opt out of any titles they do not feel are age appropriate. Class Description:

What does it take to plan and host a successful food event for a community?

In this leadership-focused, real-world course, students take on the role of event planners, hosts, and coordinators as they design and execute two connected community experiences: the Hoosier Food Experience (Week 11) and the True North Pitch-In Cookbook Launch Event (Week 12). Designed for older students, this course challenges them to think beyond the kitchen and consider every detail that goes into serving and engaging multiple groups within our community.

- In Week 11, students will plan and support the Hoosier Food Experience, working alongside other classes as families taste, explore, and interact with student-created food displays. They will need to stay after classes this week.
- In Week 12, students will bring everything together as they host and run the culminating Pitch-In Cookbook Launch Event for the full True North community. They will need to stay after classes this week.

Students will:

- Plan and organize large-scale food events for True North families and participating classes
- Collaborate with other student groups contributing to the cookbook and food experience
- Help coordinate food setup, flow of guests, and overall event logistics
- Contribute dishes or elements to the event as part of the “pitch-in” experience
- Welcome, guide, and interact with guests throughout both events

Students will also take part in promoting and advertising these experiences, helping build excitement and invite the community into both Week 11 and Week 12 events.

As the culminating experience of our culinary study, students will continue exploring our driving question:

How can we, as culinary students, use food to tell the story of our community?

This course blends leadership, collaboration, and real-world application—empowering students to take ownership of events that celebrate the work of the entire True North community.
