#### Mission Statement:


Our desire is to unite families through a Christian worldview to nurture and empower children to be life-long learners who always seek God first.

#### MORE ABOUT LITTLE LEARNERS: TN EARLY CHILDHOOD CLASSES

#### Welcome, Little Learners!

At True North, we know the early childhood years are an incredibly important time for laying a foundation of lifelong learning. It is a time when play dominates the learning process, and natural curiosity and exploration are the best teachers. We know that children are born learners, eager to explore their environments, and that play is actually very important work!

This year at True North, we wanted to focus on making a dedicated space for our littlest learners to play, a space that would further ignite their curiosity, and a space that would help activate their own natural desire to learn. That's why we have created 'Little Learners'; a new class structure for our littlest learners at True North.

'Little Learners' will encompass our Early Childhood Classes at True North; serving our 3s Class, 4s Class, and 5s Class. We will have a dedicated, individual classroom for each age group—their "Homeroom"—that will be overseen by their Lead Teacher, and their Assistant Teachers. But, during the entirety of our Wednesday class time, each age group will also have Activity Rotation Time where they will rotate through 3 additional classrooms and unique learning environments: 'Learning Lab', 'Tinker Town', and 'Move & Groove'.

Your child will begin their day in their Homeroom, then after a 'Welcome Circle', they will begin their Activity Rotation Time, traveling with their Assistant Teachers to 'Learning Lab', 'Tinker Town', and 'Move & Groove. \*Their Lead Teacher will hang back in their Homeroom, to welcome the other rotating age groups and to facilitate their assigned Activity Rotation. During Activity Rotation Time, your child will spend approximately 30min in each class (45min with transition times built-in) engaged in age-appropriate, hands-on activities, that are play-based and FUN! Then, they will rotate back to their Homeroom for a 'Snack and Storytime' and to complete their final rotation activity. Each day will end with a 'Wrap-Up Circle' in their Homeroom, before Parent Pick-Up.

#### **Class Objectives:**

Students will rehearse Finding Nemo Kids for one year and will have two performances tentatively on April 26, 2025 with a dress rehearsal on April 25, 2025. Location is TBD and tickets will be \$5 general admission.

#### **Committing to Drama class requires:**

- 1. This is a one-year long class. You must be willing to commit to being in drama both semesters.
- 2. Families must be in attendance for dress rehearsal before the performance and available most of the day on performance day. (Tentatively April 25/26, 2025.)
- 3. Costumes WILL BE provided for this production. Students will be expected to provide their own long sleeve black shirt, black leggings/black pants, and stage shoes (black jazz/dance/flat shoes).
- 4. Each student will be responsible for practicing and memorizing their lines, songs, and choreography at home. (see syllabus for details on weekly plans)
- 5. Families must be willing to stay after co-op for extra rehearsals occasionally.
- 6. Parents must be willing to volunteer during performance weekend. (ex. set up/tear down stage, stage mom in the wings, costumes, fundraising, etc)
- 7. Students should be willing to audition. However, any student who doesn't wish to audition is welcome to participate and will be placed in the ensemble! (Auditions will be held on September 25th after co-op.)



- THERE MAY BE SOME OUT OF CLASS WORK REQUIRED. For students to make their vision a reality they may need to take their work home and bring pieces together. Designing an individual workflow on week 2 will help them know how much work will need to be done at home.
