An Ashburton Dream Fulfilled by Hard Work and Many Volunteers!

This spring marked the completion of a planting effort along Callaway Avenue between Liberty Heights and Sequoia that began in 2023. At our final planting on June 13, 12 volunteers came together



to plant, mulch, and stake 2 apricot, 2 mulberry, 2 Asian pear, and 2 almond trees on the first median strip at Liberty Heights. We even received some unexpected help from firefighters who were in the neighborhood conducting smoke alarm checks.

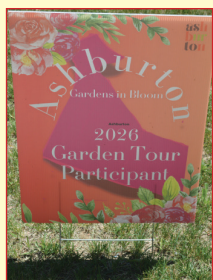
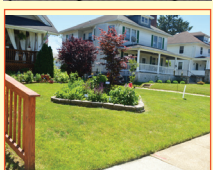
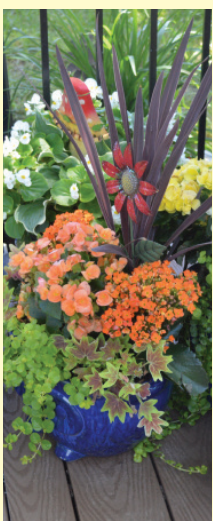
Since the project began, 126 volunteers have helped to plant 60 trees and 27 shrubs and pollinator plants on the Callaway medians from Liberty Heights to Sequoia. Those medians are now fully planted, providing beauty, shade, environmental benefits, and a lasting investment in our neighborhood.
