1) Abuse and Human Trafficking

A dangerous life can be overwhelming; some would ask why one does not simply leave, but there are so many reasons this is not so easily accomplished; fear of violent reprisal and not having safe place to go being two of the most notable, as well as caring for a child, if one is a parent.

In addition, one may not have funds, access to personal documents such as their birth certificate (which may have taken), or also have a medical condition that requires treatment which they cannot obtain on their own (again, due to lack of funds, or perhaps transportation, among other reasons).

2) Cost Assistance

Even if one does their utmost to save, find deals, and take care of things themselves, they may not find it possible to achieve certain things, such as move, afford housing, or make repairs for the winter.

Some see accepting assistance as a sign of weakness or using others. However, asking for aid demonstrates that one is able to see and acknowledge their limits, and allows one to better care for themselves and, if applicable, their family, so that they can do more in the future. In addition, asking for help can take much inner strength.

One should not feel ashamed if they seek, apply for, and accept such resources; that is what they are for, and they put one in a better position to be healthy.

7) Surviving Without A Home

For various reasons, even with the resources in Kalamazoo County, individuals can be homeless – lack of space, discrimination, and an inability to be within a location's rules because of an uncontrollable medical condition (along with no access to appropriate medical care) are just some reasons that may prevent one from obtaining or retaining shelter.

An individual without a steady place to live may not have access to a computer; Kalamazoo Hope is primarily meant to be an online service. However, hopefully, either through a friend, family member, library, or some other source, this material can be obtained.
