Summer Camps 101

Hill Country Parent provides a guide to programs you can research in one spot. Consider selecting with purpose to provide some growth for your child in areas you feel they may benefit from. Some **camps** even center on personal growth offering self-esteem, confidence, educational motivations, and social comforts, to name a few.

An important detail to consider is not all camps are created equal While researching, be sure and look into the licensing status. Depending on the size and activities some programs in Texas may not be regulated by the state, or are in the process of getting licensed resulting in ratios and requirements not being verified by a third party. Each website is required to list the status and the license and DHS provides a list you can search for online. This can really be a valuable piece of information. with so many programs available, it's a wonderful piece of mind to have.

A little intention can go a long way. Help stimulate your child with a program based on their favorite interest and create for them not only the opportunity to grow in whatever field they enjoy, but meet new friends who share that interest. Learning from each other they develop the independence to continue their passion at other points throughout the year. Often camps take hands on activities to the max fun factor. Having the opportunity to work hands on with projects gives children the chance to explore their creativity and remember the fun of learning.

Another great benefit several programs provide is zero screen time. Local experts like Kelly Newcom, with Brave Parenting and Mandy Majors with NextTalk, offer podcasts you can look up to dive deep into the details but overall one thing is clear, dependence on technology is hurting our children. According to the CDC, 7% of all children 3-17 are diagnosed with anxiety, surpassing each generation before them, showing a problem. At camp, everyone has the opportunity to reinvent oneself and this can create all the difference for some children who unfortunately run into social struggles in schools. Being around new peers allows for many positive growths including the opportunity for teamwork, making new friends, and gaining that independence of who they are without any stigmas getting in the way.

Exploring passions and indepth learning, staying active and away from screen time, staying healthy, avoiding summer slide, and conquering social challenges can be benefits to look forward to with Summer Camp programs. Encouraging Kids To Read

Reading can have a profound impact on a child's life in and out of the classroom. Reading can help a young student develop a more extensive vocabulary, and a study from the Federal Interagency Forum on Child and Family Statistics found that reading to young children promotes language acquisition, making it easier for them to learn a foreign language. That's a significant advantage for children growing up in a world that's increasingly global.



But reading has benefits outside the classroom as well. Reading can provide an escape from the daily arind, which is something even today's youngsters can appreciate. Reading also is a great way for kids to relax and unwind while simultaneously giving their brains a workout.

While many parents recognize the impact reading can have on their children, it's no secret that getting kids to embrace reading can be difficult. Distractions such as video games, social media and even the great outdoors are all there to draw kids away from reading. But parents who want to instill a love of reading in their children can still take steps to ensure their kids don't miss out on the kids to read up on those interests, benefits of a good book.



* Read to your children. Numerous studies have discovered various benefits of reading to children when they are young. The National Center for Education Statistics notes that children whose parents read to them typically become better readers and perform better in school. Reading to children early on is the first step toward fostering a love of reading kids will develop and continue throughout their lives. Many parents read to their children at night before bedtime, but any time of day will suffice.

* Don't be discouraged if kids are not interested in books. While reading fiction can help develop a youngster's imagination, parents should not be discouraged if kids don't want to read books. Reading the newspaper, magazines and even comic books can help kids develop strong reading skills and an extensive vocabulary and, in the case of comic books, inspire their imaginations. Young sports fans might be more inclined to read the sports page than a novel, so let them do so. Kids are more likely to embrace reading if what they're reading interests them, so encourage even if that reading does not involve picking up a book.



* Get your youngster his or her own library card. Thanks to the popularity of e-readers, many adults would be hard pressed to locate their local library if asked to do so. But visiting the library is a great way to encourage kids to read, especially if kids have their own library cards. Kids with their own library cards tend to look at visits to the library as shopping trips where they get to make their own choices about what they're taking home with them. And once kids reach a certain age, they can visit the library on their own.


* Share your own reading experiences with children. Kids look up to their parents and often want to mimic their behavior. So parents

can set a good example by reading as well. On trips to the library, check out your own book. While you might not want to discuss every book you read with your children, discuss the books they're reading. Chances are you read many of those same books vourself when you were a child, and discussing books with your child is a great way to improve his or her reading comprehension.

Distractions abound for today's youngsters, who might not embrace reading as readily as they do video games or social networking. But parents can take many steps to instill a love of reading in their kids that will last a lifetime.

Spring and Summer Activities

11 FREE OR CHEAP FAMILY ACTIVITIES TO DO OUTDOORS THIS SUMMER

When you think of Texas in the summer what is the first word to come to mind? HOT. Painfully hot, brutally hot, I'm-not-stepping-foot-outside hot. But our kids have been cooped up in school all year and need to enjoy some time outdoors exploring nature and the world around them. Here are some free or relatively inexpensive family outdoor activities to try this summer.

Think back to your Childhood: One of my favorite memories from summertime evenings was catching fireflies. My brother and I would run around our vard with nets and put a few fireflies in a mason jar with air holes poked in the lid. That's probably not the nicest thing for the bugs, so if you choose this option be sure to research it. Fireflies need moisture in the air, so you'll need to wet an apple slice and place it in the jar and be sure to release them the next morning. If trapping bugs in a jar doesn't appeal to you, just capture one in your hand and mesmerize your children by watching it light up.

Stargazing: Become familiar with the lunar cycle and pick a night when there is a new moon. The night sky will be illuminated with stars. If you don't have a yard or you live in a lightpolluted area find a park that's off the beaten path. Find out when the next meteor shower will happen, and head out for an evening of stargazing.

Watch the Sunrise or the Sunset-This is hard to manage with working parents' schedules. Pick a weekend day. If you can manage a camping trip, head towards Fredericksburg and watch the sunrise or set from on top of Enchanted Rock. Seeing something so majestic is good for the whole family. You might not know how much you need this too!

Landa Park in New Braunfels-There are trails, pools, and plavarounds. Wander around the park and enjoy the scenery and bring a picnic lunch with extra bread for the ducks. There is a beautiful spring fed pool originally built in the early 1900's. It has kept my family entertained for hours. There's a two story tall slide into the water along with a sturdy rope swing over the deep end. For the smaller kiddos there is a shallow end of the springs with a smaller slide and water features as well as a separate baby/ pool splash pad area for the littles. There is an entry fee for the pool (\$6 for adults. \$5 for ages 3-12, and free to kids 2 and under) but you are welcome to bring food and drinks and stay all day. There is a shady playground within the springs area so your kids can take a break from the water and play in the shade.



San Antonio Japanese Tea Garden -Located in Brackenridge Park the Japanese Tea Gardens are free and open to the public. Renovated in 2007, the park has beautiful walkways, stone arch bridges, islands, Koi ponds and aquatic plants. You'll feel like you've stepped into a different world. Bring the whole family and remember that the walkways are wheelchair accessible.

Visit one of our beautiful State Parks. Garner State Park in Concan, Texas has 11 miles of scenic trails to explore or COOL OFF and tube, swim, and kayak in the crystal clear waters of the Frio River. Camping is available and you can enjoy 1940's style juke box dances at the park's pavilion on the weekends. Guadalupe River State Park in Spring Branch, Texas is another great place to cool off. Tube the Guadalupe river and bring a cooler of snacks and water to keep yourself hydrated.

Get Fit-Join in on a FREE Fit Pass 5Kat Pearsall Park in San Antonio. It takes place on Saturday, June 9th. A great way to get the whole family involved in fitness!

Rio Vista Park-San Marcos-Head north on 35 and enjoy all that San Marcos has to offer. Rio Vista Park is free and on the beautiful San Marcos River. 72 degrees all year round, this spring fed river will cool you down in no time. Drive around town to see the mermaid statues made by local artists and visit downtown's Paper Bear Heartworks Co for one of a kind gifts, many made by local artisans. Phil Hardberger Park-Located in San

Antonio, this park boasts woodsy, bike friendly trails, playscapes and art sculptures.

Cave Without A Name-11 miles NE of Boerne is a beautiful, natural, living cavern. If you are willing to spend a little more than usual for a family outing, this is a must see. Take a tour through the caves and see stalagmites, stalagmites, and delicate soda straws. Best part? It's 66 degrees year round.

Swimming in Wimberley- There are two amazing swimming holes in this charming town. Jacobs Well is a perennial karstic spring flowing from the bed of Cypress Creek. Blue Hole is one of the most loved swimming holes in Texas. Take a dip in the cool waters of Cypress Creek at Blue Hole and enjoy the gorgeous Cypress Trees and rope swings found surrounding the water.




