IMPORTANT REASONS TO DRAIN YOUR POOL

Chemical Effectiveness— We recommend a complete pool drain every year but at a minimum every two years for a healthy pool, this will also help lower chemical usage and calcium deposits on tile surfaces. Pool water that has been treated with chemicals regularly, can become impossible to clean with chemicals after years of use. Draining your pool and refilling it will give it a fresh start. Pool water is exposed to chemicals over the years and over time this can cause the pool to be more challenging to clean. If you and others use your pool often, there are also biological remains like oils from people's skin and hair, and dead skin cells. On top of pure biological remains, there can also be chemical remains like hair spray, sunscreen, makeup, nail polish, and tanning lotion, among others. Sometimes you can drain and refill the water only, while other times, you may have to clean the floor and walls of your pool with an Acid wash, Chlorine Wash or Soda Blasting of Tiles.

<u>Calcium buildup and staining-</u> Living in area that has especially hard water such as Lake Havasu City, can cause calcium deposits to form as the water evaporates during the summer months. When the good water evaporates consistently it causes more calcium to build up on the tiles over time and can become harder to remove therefore, making it necessary to drain the pool and do a soda blasting. Draining your pool annually will help to slow this process.

Total Dissolved Solids (TDS)— The most important reason to drain your pool is TDS levels. When TDS levels get too high, they interfere with the chemicals that keep the water sanitary and clear. If the TDS is high, it will take more and more chemicals to balance the water which can be harsh on the skin and even damage the pool itself. A point is reached where the water cannot be maintained properly no matter how many chemicals are used. We recommend draining your pool every year preferentially and every 2 years at the most to keep TDS levels low. How often your pool needs to be drained depends on several factors, including overall use. If the pool is partially drained every winter, this dilutes TDS levels and will extend the interval between complete water changes.
