LMTC Emergency Drill Information (2022)

Our school will practice safety drills often

First Aid/CPR We have First Aid kits available inside and outside. We are First Aid and CPR certified.

Emergency Kits We have a 1 year supply of food, water, lighting, cooking and other emergency kits available for use in our garage at all times.

Meeting Place

Our class meeting place will be the street light on the eastside of our front yard. This is where you can meet us during an emergency if we are evacuated. If we have to evacuate further from our house, our meeting place will be the stop sign on Powatan and Occoneechee (west of our house).

Local Emergency

Try not to tie up the phone line, texting is better. If you are in doubt, come to the school to assist us or to pick up your child and get to safety. If you are on sight during an emergency the best thing to do is to stay calm. Let's work together to keep the atmosphere and all children calm and comfortable until needs are met.

Hurricane/Severe Storm

Most likely we will know ahead of time and close the school if the local authorities encourage us to stay home. If inclimate weather occurs while school is in session, we will follow WCPSS school closure plans.

Poisons

We do not have anything toxic or poisonous in the preschool rooms. We do store cleaning supplies and other chemicals for emergencies and camping use in our living area or garage. We keep these materials out of sight and out of reach. Your child will never be unattended anywhere on the premises. In the unlikely case of contact we will call Poison Control and follow their directions.

Fire

We have up to date smoke detectors around the house and a fire extinguisher located in the kitchenette area. In the case of a fire see the exit plan. If the fire is downstairs, we have a window leader to help get the kids outside. We will gather at our meeting place if we evacuate during a fire.
