Remember, the battle against domestic violence is not just fought in shelters and courtrooms; it's fought in the hearts and minds of clubs and communities.

By participating in these initiatives, you're not just raising funds; you're raising hope!

- Collect new or gently used jewelry and distribute to children to give their mother who is in a Domestic Violence Program.
- Provide hygiene bags to a safe house for clients as they come out of abusive situations.
- Provide personal and housewarming items for clients who may have had to leave everything behind.
- Host a Charity Cookbook Sale.
   This involves compiling a cookbook with recipes donated by local chefs, celebrities, or family favorites from club/community members. Each recipe comes with a story or a message of hope.

- Provide information in your club's monthly newsletter regarding all forms of Domestic and Sexual Violence
- Wear purple the entire month of October and promote this in your community.
- Host a Domestic Violence walk in your community
- Host a community gift card drive to benefit your local shelter.
