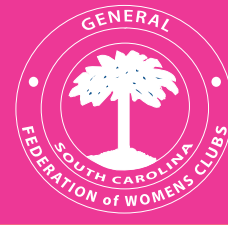

## PRESIDENT'S SPEECH TO GFWC-SC 2024 CONVENTION BODY

This is not an office I ever thought I would hold, nor did I ever say to myself, "I think I want to be state president of the General Federation of Women's Clubs of South Carolina!" Yet, here I stand, humbled and honored by the faith you have placed in me to lead our beloved state Federation for the next two years.

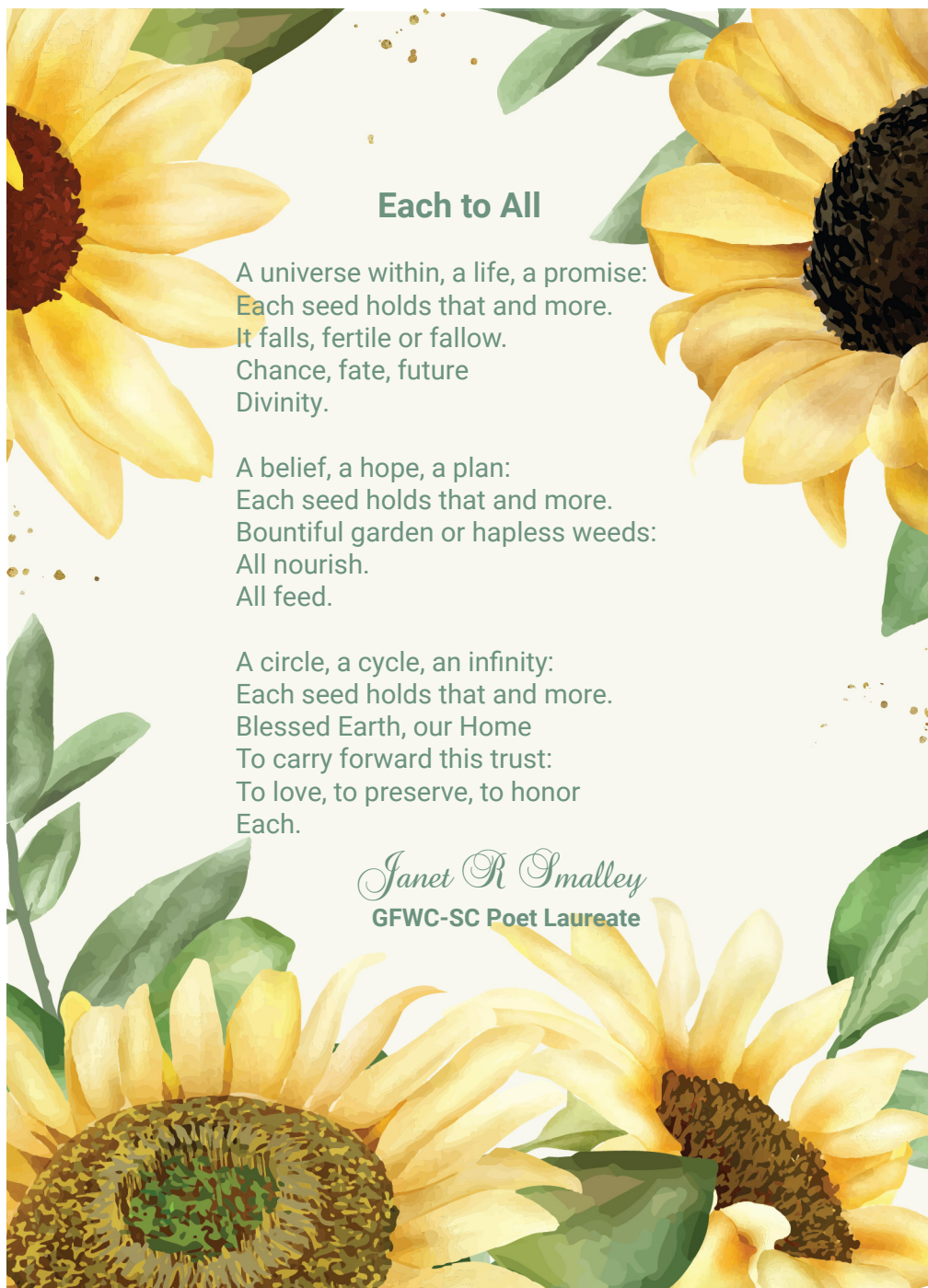

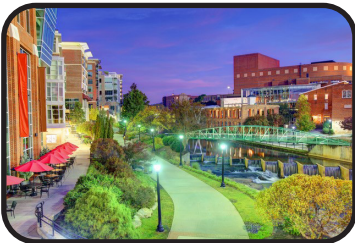
