Congratulations to all of the award winners and a special “thank you” to all of the Community Service Chairs and Advancement Area Chairs for your reports and presentations. You all did a wonderful job! A complete listing of awards presented is included in this issue of Clubwoman.

Program Council met prior to the opening of convention and the following items were approved for recommendation to the GFWC-SC Board of Directors:

- Summer Board be held in Columbia on July 20, 2013, and that the respective eight District Conferences be set by each District to be held in August or early September, coinciding with the start of the 2013-2014 club year.
- GFWC-SC Silver Awards be discontinued. Silver Award Certificates will be presented at Convention in place of silver pieces. The silver pieces will either be returned to their respective donor or retired to GFWC-SC Headquarters as directed. Districts will vote at their District Conference on whether to continue to present District Silver at their District Conference.
- Voted to review the current reporting guidelines and procedures for awarding of silver awards associated with Community Service Projects and Advancement Area Projects. The recommendations will be discussed and voted upon at the next Program Council meeting at the July 19, 2013 Summer Board meeting.
- To align with GFWC, GFWC-SC will discontinue the Publicity Book Award effective with the 2013 reporting year.
- Approved the elimination of the monetary award associated with the Shining Star Awards for this administration and to have the monies generated by the 50/50 fundraisers at convention to go to the GFWC-SC General Fund.
- Approved an additional award for the 2012-2014 GFWC-SC President’s Special Project to be called the GFWC-SC Patriot Award.

Program Council will meet again on Friday, July 19, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. at the Inn @ USC, 1619 Pendleton Street, Columbia. Entry to the parking lot is on Pickens Street. 115th General Federation of Women's Clubs of SC Convention  
April 26-27, 2013, Columbia, South Carolina**

April 26-27, 2013, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina

The 115th Annual Convention for the General Federation of Women's Clubs of South Carolina was held April 26 - 27, 2012, at the Marina Inn in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. President Jo Ann Bolchoz called the meeting to order at 11:31 a.m. Invocation was given by Patricia Ezell, GFWC-SC Chaplain. The North Myrtle Beach High School Junior ROTC presented the colors. National Anthem was sung by North Myrtle Beach High School Student Heather Hiley. Pledge of Allegiance and South Carolina Pledge was led by Kathie Walker, North Central District President. "Collect for Clubwomen" was led by Laurie O'Kelly, GFWC-SC Advisor and Immediate Past President. National Pledge of Junior Clubwomen was led by Katie Jones-Moydell, Director-elect of Junior Clubs. Sarah Thomas introduced the guest speaker, Marilyn Hatley, Mayor of North Myrtle Beach. Mayor Hatley issued the official "Welcome to the Beach" and Christy Sexton, President of the Grand Strand Junior Woman's Club gave the response. Rachael Fulmer, Director of Junior Clubs, said Grace. A Fashion Show hosted by Dress Barn with models from the Eastern District was held during lunch.

Following lunch, Judy Soltis, Midlands District President, introduced the GFWC-SC Past Presidents and GFWC-SC Executive Committee. Marian St. Clair, GFWC Recording Secretary, and Deb Strahanoski, GFWC Treasurer, provided "Greetings from GFWC".

Caroline Mahaffey, GFWC-SC First Vice President, and Kristin Fields, GFWC-SC Treasurer, presided over the presentation of Rating Sheet and Contribution Sheet Silver Awards and Certificates. Janet Prince, GFWC-SC Second Vice President and Dean of Departments presided over the presentation of GFWC Advancement Awards and Reports. Lois Black, Communication and Identity Chairman, presented the Communication and Identify Awards; Tammy Garland, Fundraising Chairman, presented the Fundraising Award; Pat Estep, Leadership Chairman, presented the Leadership Awards and announced that Judy Soltis, the Midlands District President, will be the 2013 LEADS Candidate for South Carolina; Caroline Mahaffey, GFWC-SC First Vice President and Membership Chairman, presented the Membership Awards. The Public Policy and Legislation Awards were presented by Janet Agnew, Legislation and Public Policy Chairman, and the Women's History and Resource Center Awards were presented by Karen Kaylor, WHRC Chairman. Caroline Brown, Special Assistant to the President made announcements. The convention recessed at 3:30 p.m. until the "Unveiling of the Stars" Masquerade Ball & Junior Auction at 7:00 p.m.

The convention resumed at 7:15 p.m. Sandy Kealey, North Myrtle Beach Woman's Club offered grace. The Junior Auction "It's In the Bag" was held through-out the evening as entertainment. Convention was recessed at 9:30 p.m. until the business session on Saturday, April 27, 2013.

Reports from Standing Committees were given. Bobbie Sox, Chairman of the Constitution and Bylaws Committee, reported no changes to the Constitution and

Bylaw this year. Juliet Casper, GFWC-SC Recording Secretary gave the GFWC-SC Board of Directors Report; Ann Malpass, Chairman of the Headquarters Committee, gave the headquarters report. Jan Hadwin presented the Headquarters Budget for 2012-2013 and it was adopted as presented. Linda Ham, Chairman Budget & Finance, and Kristin Fields, GFWC-SC Treasurer, presented the 2013-2014 General Fund Budget. The 2012-2013 Budget was approved and adopted as presented. Reports from the GFWC-SC Officers' were given: GFWC-SC Director of Junior Clubs Rachael Fulmer, GFWC-SC Treasurer Kristin Fields, GFWC-SC Recording Secretary, Juliet Casper, GFWC-SC Second Vice President Janet Prince, GFWC-SC First Vice President, Caroline Mahaffey, and GFWC-SC President Jo Ann Bolchoz.

Janet Prince, GFWC-SC Second Vice President, presented information regarding the Jennie Award nominations. Debra (Deb) Strahanoski, GFWC Treasurer, presented the United Nations "Shot@Life" program. Eula Leaber, Chairman, International Outreach, presented the certificates and awards for the Community Service Programs International Outreach, with Jolene Bryant, Chairman, International Outreach Partnership, presenting the Community Service Programs International Outreach Partnership certificates and awards. The certificates and awards for Community Service Programs Public Service were presented by Misty Konow, Chairman, Public Issues; and by Libby Love, Chairman, Public Issues Partnership.

The Credentials Report was given by Elizabeth Herring, Chairman, with voting strength 88, non-voting 41, total attending 129. GFWC-SC Recording Secretary Juliet Casper read the Rules of Elections beginning at 11:05 a.m. Jolene Bryant, Chairman State Elections Committee gave the Elections Committee Report. President Jo Ann Bolchoz presided over the Elections, Confirmations and Nominations. A vote was taken to affirm the District Elections for the following: GFWC-SC Board of Trustees, GFWC-SC Board of Trustees of Progress Foundation, and GFWC-SC Scholarship Committee. GFWC-SC Recording Secretary Juliet Casper read the letter of endorsement from the Woman's Club of the Midlands and the recommendation from the GFWC-SC Board of Directors to nominate Jackie Boland as a candidate for GFWC Southern Region President. The convention body voted unanimously to adopt this recommendation. GFWC-SC Recording Secretary Juliet Casper read the letter of endorsement from the St. Andrews Woman's Club and the recommendation from the GFWC-SC Board of Directors to nominate Marian St. Clair as a candidate for GFWC Second Vice President. The convention body voted unanimously to adopt this recommendation.

The convention recessed at 12:27 PM until the "Rolling Out the Red Carpet for Our Stars" Banquet.

After dinner, Katie Jones-Moydell and Rachael Fulmer, GFWC-SC Director of Junior Clubs, presented Junior Clubs Special Project "Read to a Child" Award. At the annual convention of the General Federation of Women's Clubs- S. C. in Myrtle Beach, S.C., The Woman's Club of Columbia's president, Carolyn Donges, was awarded the prestigious Patriot Award for its contribution to two of the federation's special projects: Canines for Veterans and Sew Much Comfort. The service dogs are being trained at the naal base in Charleston, and after training they are given to disabled veterans at no cost. It cost approximately \$20,000 to train one dog. The club was awarded, from their endowment, a grant to assist in this training. The Sew Much Comfort is a project that alters regular clothing enabling an amputee to wear regular clothing that is easy for them to dress themselves. The endowment awarded a grant to assist in this project.

## GFWC-SC Volunteer of the Year

June has been a clubwoman for many years - first as a member of the Woman's Club of Rock Hill for 16 years and now the York County Woman's Club which she joined in 2010, its first year. During 2012 she served as the club secretary. Her most prominent duties as secretary are the taking of the minutes, 22 hours; editing and publishing the club's newsletter, 33 hours; and assembling the club yearbook, 25 hours. She also attended the business and planning meetings, 45 hours.

### **Fundraisers:**

"Mommy and Me Tea." Held in March, this was a traditional high tea with savories, scones, and sweets for girls, mothers, and/or grandmothers. It was held at the 100-year-old home of one of the club members. June helped set up and produced the menus. 6 hours, net proceeds, \$620.

"Girlfriends Just Wanna Have Fun," - a lunch, fashion show, and card party held in September. Members prepared all the food. This is an annual event. June did most of the promotional materials, collected door prizes, and worked at the event. Proceeds went to Safe Passage, a shelter for abused women and children, and Tender Hearts, a community outreach program for women who need help, 10 hours, net proceeds, \$1553.

"A Frog Hopping" - a community art project. June created the promotional literature and letters to potential sponsors, 25 hours. Although we did raise thousands of dollars for this project, all was ultimately refunded due to lack of community support.

"McAlisters night," in which members and/or spouses ate on specified nights during the club year. McAlisters deli donated a portion of the night's proceeds which we used toward college scholarships for the child of a veteran or active duty soldier, 3 hours, net proceeds, \$557.

### **Projects:**

"Relay for Life." June helped with the setup for the survivors' dinner, made cupcakes for the walk, and donated \$125, 2 hours. Relay for Life is an event in which volunteers walk laps for pledged donations. GFWC-YC total donation to the American Cancer Society, was \$1554.

"Paws in Action." GFWC-SC President's Special Project. GFWC-YC had a booth at one of the county's major fairs. We handed out literature and donation envelopes. We showed a video of a trained assistance dog. June helped with setup and designed a brochure. 6 hours.

"Walk for Alzheimers." Members of the club participated in the walk in honor of a member's husband. June personally donated \$100. Club total donations, \$585.

"Gifts for Veterans and the Elderly at Christmas." Members put together 54 Christmas bags for veterans (through the VA clinic), plus donated \$100 in gift cards from McDonald's for use when needed at the clinic. Through DSS, members provided warm-ups, socks, hats, and blankets for the elderly who have been abused or abandoned. June's out of pocket was \$120, 2 hours. Club total in-kind, \$808. Through the US Marine League, we used \$280 from our existing veterans fund and purchased toiletries, games, etc., and donated them to veterans in nursing homes in SC. June and another member purchased these items. 4 hours. Other in-kind donations, \$54 for printing and printing materials. June attended winter board, 6 hours; and the GFWC National Convention, 10 hours.

June's commitment to GFWC began in 1987 when she joined the Woman's Club of Rock Hill, where she served as president, vice president, and several committee chairmanships. For most of that time she designed and published the club directory. She also served at the state level editing and publishing the GFWC-SC Clubwoman magazine from 1990 to 2000 as well as maintaining the database of members. From 2002-2004 she served as publisher. June also was chairman of several committees including nomination of state officers.

She also volunteers at Hospice and Community Care where she works in the hospital at the front desk, assisting aides, nurses, and visitors. She also works in the office and provides respite for caregivers. June was born in rural Kentucky and after completing high school and business college, she worked as an executive secretary. Married to her husband Jim for 46 years, they have two children, Beth and James, and two granddaughters, Zoe and Natalie. June and Jim owned a printing business for 23 years. Now retired, when not volunteering, she enjoys spending time with family and friends, and playing bridge.

## GFWC-SC Woman of Distinction

Dr. Rosemary Elizabeth Althouse was awarded the GFWC-SC Woman of Distinction posthumously at the GFWC-SC Convention. Rosemary was a member of the Woman's Club of Rock Hill prior to her passing on December 20, 2012. Rosemary was a retired Professor from Winthrop University, and a published author of five textbooks in Early Childhood Education. She was a sought after speaker and a volunteer championing for children.

She was very active in her clubs Education Community Service Project and she especially loved events that impacted children the most. To honor her memory, the Woman's Club of Rock Hill has established a scholarship in her name to aid children to be able to attend church pre-schools.

She has been honored posthumously by the South Carolina Legislature and the SC Early Childhood Association dedicated their 59th statewide convention in honor of her.

Rosemary was dedicated to her community and especially to her club and the clubwomen of the Woman's Club of Rock Hill. Her influence lives on in her many students, friends and fellow clubwomen.

**From the Upstate:** I-26 E to Columbia. Merge onto I-126 via Exit 108B on left. Merge onto Huger Street. Turn left onto Gervais. Turn right onto Pickens. Take 2nd left onto Pendleton. Inn on left.

**From Aiken:** I-20 to Columbia. Merge onto I-126 via Exit 108B and follow directions as above from Upstate.

**From Myrtle Beach:** I-20 West to Columbia. Merge onto Exit 73A. Stay straight to go onto Bull St. Turn left onto Gervais. Take 1st right onto Pickens. Take 2nd left onto Pendleton. Inn on the left.

**From Aiken:** I-77 to Columbia. Exit 18 toward I20 West Columbia/ Augusta. Stay straight to go onto Bull Street. Turn left on Gervais. Take 1st right onto Pickens. Take 2nd left onto Pendleton. Inn on left.
