Progress at Headquarters!

A Grant Application was submitted last January to the Richland County Conservation Commission and after a long process, Headquarters received a grant in the amount of \$6,808 from them - 20% of which had to be paid either in kind or cash. The grant was for replacing the wooden porch flooring - front and west side of the Historic Sims-Stackhouse Mansion which is the Headquarters Building at 1511 Laurel Street in Columbia. The original bid to replace the tongue and groove porch was \$6,762.00. When the contractor started the removal of the old wood, it was noted that the joists were rotten and had to be replaced. The total cost ended up being \$11,212.00. A grant was received from The Woman's Club of Columbia to replace the concrete portion of the porch. Volunteer hours were given by a Consulting Engineer (Bob Malpass) and members of the Headquarters Committee to monitor the work until completion. Work was begun in August and completed in October. A big 'Thank You" to the Richland County Conservation Commission, The Woman's Club of Columbia and to the many volunteers who have made this possible!


