Right here in our beautiful state, we have three national cemeteries that participate:

Fort Jackson National Cemetery (Columbia)

- 585 acres acquired from Fort Jackson, a United States Army Basic Training facility, and was dedicated on October 26, 2008
- Thousands of heroes rest here

Beaufort National Cemetery

- Designated by Abraham Lincoln on February 10, 1863, Beaufort National Cemetery is one of the oldest United States National Cemeteries
- Over 18,500 graves of veterans from every conflict since the Civil War

Florence National Cemetery

• Another sacred resting place for our heroes
