You have the option to complete a Narrative Report if you would like and include this with your emailed State Statistical Form. If you need to complete a form to send with a check, please fill it out online, print the form, attach the check, and mail in. We will have a Reporting Workshop via ZOOM prior to reporting - be on the lookout!

I highly encourage you all to spend some time reviewing the **GFWC Club Manual**. The 2026-2028 version is available and full of valuable information. President Carriker has introduced multiple "Unity Projects" that touch our Federation's different areas of focus. These projects are excellent ways to tie work done in our clubs back to our national level.

Mission: Lift survivors up through collaboration, education, and advocacy.

Key Focus Areas

- **Club Collaboration** to expand statewide impact.
- **Project Enhancement** for shelters and service providers.
- **Legislative Engagement** to influence survivor-centered policy.

Understanding Abuse in South Carolina

- Major types: **domestic/partner violence, child maltreatment, elder mistreatment.**
- Forms include **physical, verbal, psychological, financial, emotional, sexual.**
- Abuse affects anyone — “*abuse doesn’t have a face.*”

Current Challenges

- Nationwide **funding cuts** reduce resources for victims.
- Impacts: **staff shortages, program loss, shelter closures, reduced survivor safety.**
- Need for **community education** on recognizing and responding to abuse.

SCCADVASA Partnership

- SCCADVASA provides **training, technical assistance, policy advocacy, and funding support.**
- Partnership strengthens statewide survivor services.

Call to Action

- **Educate communities.**
- **Engage legislators.**
- **Support shelters** through projects and collaboration.
- **Unify clubs** to amplify impact.

Mission: End period poverty through access, education, and advocacy.

Key Focus Areas:

- **Provide Access** — Free, easy availability in schools and communities.
- **Educate** — Age-appropriate information and open dialogue.
