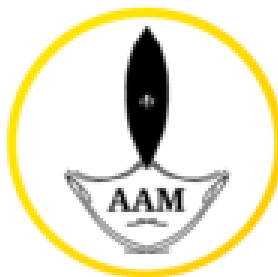

AAM PRESCHOOL

A BRIEF INTRODUCTION

'Aam Preschool' inaugurated on 2nd June, 2014 to give the village children an opportunity in education and to improve their standard of living, became the object of focus at Navapatty, Mettur Taluk.

The idea of a preschool at Navapatty village by Athiya Chinnaiyan, Managing Trustee, is to let the children of the twelve villages of Navapatty Panchayat access and benefit from the educational facilities offered by the organisation in the same building that was a health center before it was expanded to the AAM Pre school project.

“The Objective of the school is to provide Primary Education to children from remote villages of Mettur, and to improve their means of livelihood.”

In a population of approximately 10,000 in 12 villages, around 100 children were enumerated between the ages of 2 to 5 years. (Villages: Navapatti, Kavericross, Karunkaradu, Thommankaradu, Koorandipudur, Nattamangalam, Ottapalaikadu, Perumpallam, PongiannaGounder Colony, Sekkanur, JJ Nagar, Mathaiyankuttai.) Government Palvadi's (Day Care Center) of respective villages are the only exposure children between 2 to 5 years have, to a Preschool System. The AAM Preschool is a gentle exposure to the kind of facilities available in an urban Preschool System.

The main occupation of the people being farming, most of them leave their homes to other villages to work for long periods of time. Children cared for by grandparents, transportation problems of children to and from school are the main reasons children did not attend school.

Four women from the same village were chosen to school the children. It gave them a sense of familiarity and an understanding of their needs. The staff maintained proper records and registers of the children's activities and their evaluation. Children were taught to articulate words, express ideas, develop a sense of keenness seen here with the teacher.

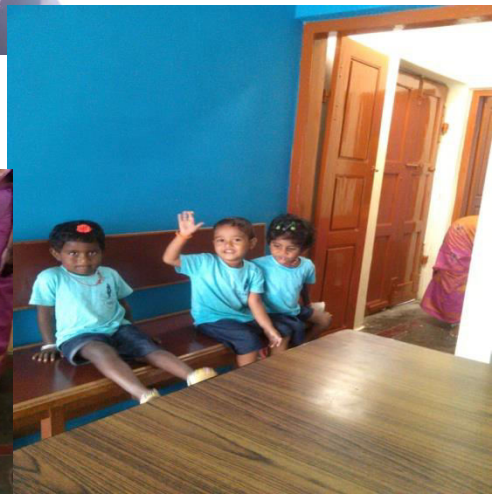

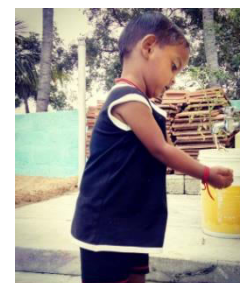
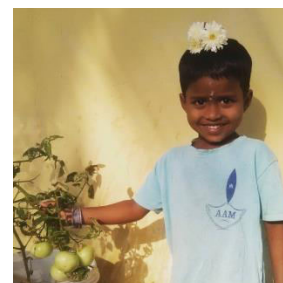
