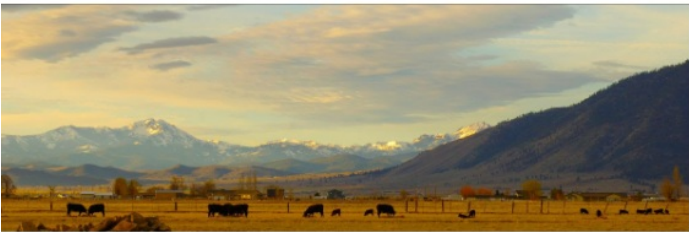

Integrated Maternal Health Services Community Advisory Council (IMHS CAC)

We want to hear your voice!

The IMHS CAC is a dedicated space for 10 moms to offer feedback and recommendations to improve the IMHS pilot program.

What is the IMHS pilot program?

Comagine Health and the Southern Nevada Pathways Community HUB have partnered with the UNLV Shadow Lane Clinic and the UNLV School of Public Health to **improve maternity care and birth outcomes for pregnant women** in Clark County, by addressing gaps that currently exist.

The focus of the group sessions will be to **collect community voices and opinions** to advise the IMHS implementation team through the pilot phase of this project.

When will the IMHS CAC meet?

The IMHS CAC will meet quarterly between June 2025 - Sept 2026. These meetings will be held in person for 90-minutes at Nevada Partners (date/time TBD). One virtual orientation will be held in June (date/time TBD) to ensure selected participants understand the IMHS project and its intended outcomes.

Requirements and Expectations

IMHS CAC members must:

- Be currently pregnant or gave birth within last three years
- Live in Clark County

IMHS CAC members must commit to:

- Attending a minimum of three out of the four in-person meetings
- Actively contributing to the conversation to improve care for pregnant women and their babies in Clark County (written feedback may be requested, but is not required)

IMHS CAC members will receive a \$100 per session stipend for their time, in-person attendance, and contribution at meetings.
