

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

What To Bring:

- Identification (if Minor or lacking capacity, also bring parent/ guardian's ID)
- Any relevant legal forms (e.g., guardianship papers if another person will sign/make decisions on behalf of patient); note: a Power of Attorney (POA) is not the same as guardianship. Patients must sign their own forms unless they lack competency (as per indicated by a court)
- Insurance Cards
- Medical records
- Filled-out registration forms (if you have them)
- List of current medications
- List of people with whom you want us to share your results (family, specialists, primary care, attorneys); referring physician automatically gets referral.

What To Expect When You Visit Us:

During your initial visit, you will meet with Dr. Lopez for about an hour for an interview. You may bring any family members/loved ones you would like to this appointment.

If you are recommended for further assessment, this testing will take anywhere from 2 to 7 hours. If you are unable to complete your testing all at once, it is possible to schedule it over two separate days.

Testing periods of greater than 4 hours include a one-hour lunch break where you can leave the clinic. If you bring your lunch, you can eat at our office.

Family members will not be able to accompany you into the testing area.

The tests that are administered measure a variety of concepts, such as memory, learning, language skills, and problem solving.

Depending on Dr. Lopez' recommendation, you may have a follow-up appointment where she will meet with you for approximately 30 minutes and go over your results. Any family members are welcome to join you. Copies of your report will be sent to your referring physician and any additional people that you specify on your Release of Information form.
