As a Drug Court Judge, I worked with The Serenity House and its staff for over twenty years. I could count on them to enforce their rules and not allow the use of any drugs or alcohol. Their staff kept the Court advised on the progress of the individual, good or bad. They worked with each man to develop responsibility and realize that they must account for their actions. The men were and still are required to get a job, pay weekly rent, attend recovery meetings and not use drugs or alcohol. Graduates of the program can be found acting as sponsors or providing counsel to the residents. The community needs this program to work with other agencies to combat the problems we have with drugs and alcohol.
