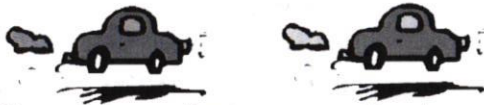
We are sure that she will instill in your child that God is just as real today and is working as He was in the days of the Bible.

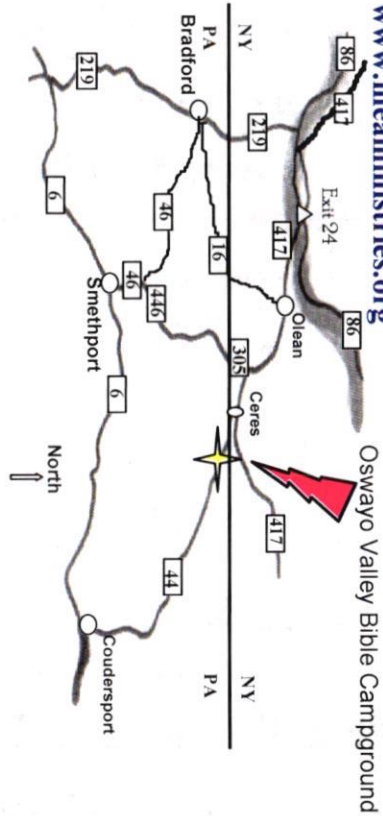
