We know that you will be touched by the power of God during these services that will both stir and challenge you through the ministering of the Word.

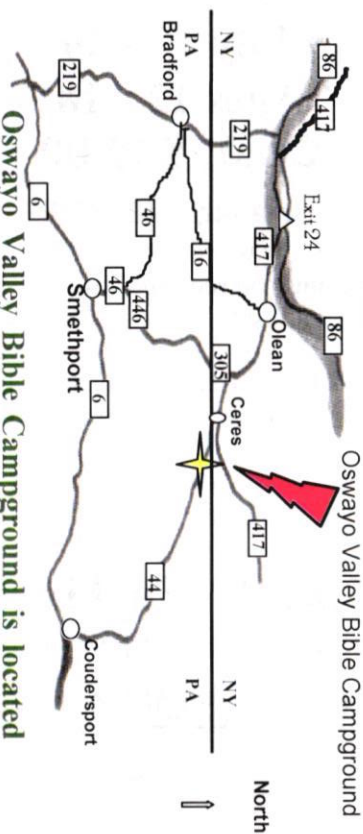
