Now we have a friend for life and he is praising the Lord for the food that he now has! We were also able to take more food to two different churches in Santiago. It was a wondrous time to be able to share hope with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

We have also started traveling and preaching at the different churches here in La Vega. As Jayma preaches, Jeff is able to translate the messages. The Holy Spirit has moved in mighty ways in the services. We are able to bring food for each of the families in the church and a bag for them to share with a neighbor or family that God leads them to. We want them to be able to join in also in being Jesus’ hands and feet extended.



Now we get to the main purpose of this letter, Christmas! This is the time of year that we get most excited about. Last year we had a wonderful donation of about \$800 dollars that came in to buy christmas gifts for the children in the churches here in the Dominican Republic. We purchased around 200 gifts ranging from \$2-\$5 dollars and wrapping paper to wrap them. We had Christmas parties at 4 different churches. We enjoyed playing games and sharing the gifts with the children. Many of them told us it was the first time they had ever received a gift for christmas. They loved every part of it! After the party, we went to
