Theme: Jesus, Our Savior & Friend!

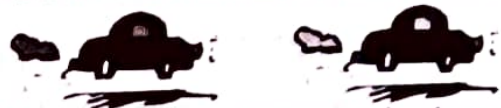

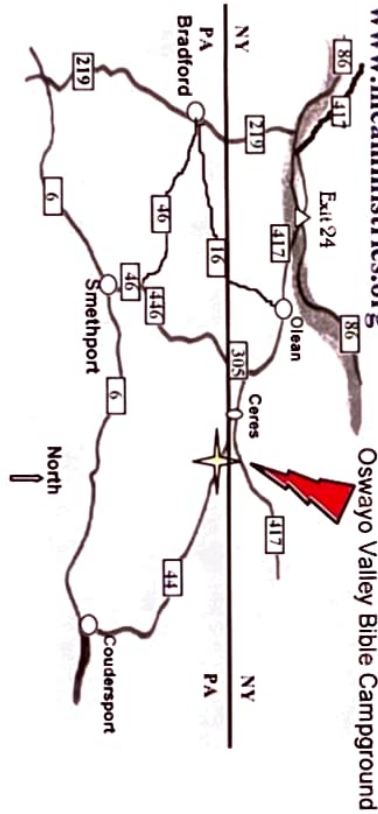
