Call to Order: Joe Sesack called the Zoom meeting to order at 7PM In the interest of the Admiral's time we will let him address the board first.

Admiral Alfultis understands that many parents are disappointed but at this time the campus will be closed for ship departure. Maritime must abide by the current CDC and NYSDOH guidelines to keep our students and staff safe. He stated that Maritime is the only Maritime academy doing port visits this summer. The Admiral assured us that the departure will be live streamed and we will be notified of viewing points along the East River. All of these safety measures will get us to the long term goal of at the very least having the parents of seniors at the ship return, in person July graduation, and a B cruise.

The Admiral again addressed the license exam. He understands that students are concerned that seminar was completed months ago and they will need to study for the exams while at sea. They will be receiving 67 days of seminar review for the exam. He is very confident that the students will have a very high success rate.

The Admiral addressed the COVID testing and vaccines. In the last few weeks there have been 1100 test with only 2 positives. There has been no student who has taken the vaccine that has tested positive.

The Admiral thanked us for our offer to donate the large supply of 2020 SST shirts and hats to the cadets. He, Captain McManus, and the administration feels that they don't want to focus on what they couldn't do last year. They want to focus on what they have been able to achieve and that is getting our cadets out to sea. He understands that we have taken a huge financial hit and assured us that he hopes to have us back on campus for upcoming events. We explained the need to meet the freshman parents which he understood. He hopes to have us at Indoc graduation this August.

Dr. Jennifer Waters, Provost at Maritime College, thanked the Parents Association for the supporting the administration during this difficult year.

The goal of the Provost and the Admiral is for full face to face class and sports in the fall.
