• SUNY Chancellor John King was on campus today along with many elected officials, started off on the new training ship and were able to speak with several cadets that sailed on the training ship this past January. Met with intern students. Press release announcement about our safety training with offshore winds. Right now it's just a center with many different elements. It's more of a training mariner program. We are certified to administer this training.

- Leigh Winfrey is also on the call (Dean of Engineering). She met with students who took the license tests to discuss concerns
- The school is responsible for providing training and resources to prepared them for the exam, they are involved with facilitating testing, the maritime academy is not involved in creating the content, selecting the questions. This is the responsibility of the US Coast Guard.
