

# RECYCLE GUIDELINES



## WHAT YOU CAN RECYCLE:



### *Aluminum*

*Aluminum & Tin Cans:*

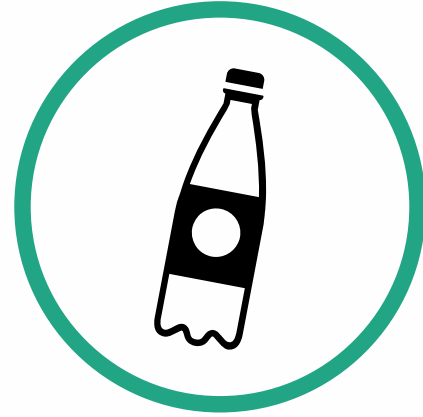
*Examples: Soup, Pet food, Soda, Beer*

*Preparation: Empty and rinse clean. Do not flatten. Lids and Labels can be left on.*

*Items Not Accepted: Scrap Metal such as: Toasters, Pots, Frying Pans, Coat Hangers.*



### *TIN CANS*



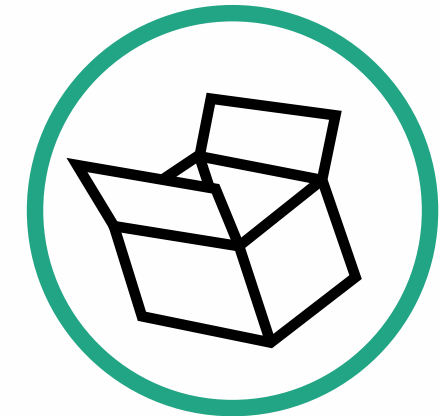
### *PLASTICS*

*Plastic*

*Examples: Clear and Colored Plastic Bottles, Soda, Milk and Water Jugs, Detergent, Bleach, etc.*

*Preparation: Discard caps, empty, rinse and clean.*

*The bottle must have the recycling symbol and numbers 1, 2, 4, and 7*



### *CARDBOARD*

*Cardboard*

*Examples: Brown Boxes only and Brown Paper Bags Waxed Cardboard, Show Boxes, Gift Boxes and Cereal Boxes*

*Preparation: Cardboard and bags must be emptied, flattened and less than 2'x2'*

*Items Not Accepted: No packing materials such as Styrofoam peanuts. No frozen food boxes*



### *GLASS*

*Glass*

*Examples: Food and Beverage Bottles and Jars – Clear, Green, and Browns*

*Preparation: Empty, rinse clean, lids need to be removed but labels may be left on.*



### *PAPERS*

*Papers*

*Examples: Newspapers (including inserts) junk mail, and Magazines*

*Preparation: Bundle and tie separately. We accept all paper.*
