



Thank you for choosing Recycle Depot. For your convenience, below is our Open Container Regulations and general information about your container rental.

- 1) An Extra fee will be added for overweight containers and will be charged on card given at time of order. (see weight caps below)
- 2) Containers must be kept at water level - No overloaded containers
- 3) Containers must be moved by our personnel only
- 4) No hazardous materials - No food debris, chemicals, paints or sludges. You will be responsible for any legal disposal consequence.

The rental period is 7 days:

Containers are rented for 7 days. Rent will be charged on the 8th day. Please call us when you are done and ready for removal; we won't just come and pick up the dumpster. It is best for you to call us the day before you are done so we can put you on the schedule for removal.

The pricing includes a specific weight cap:

Although it is clear that some items are very heavy, we can't predict what the weight will be when the container is filled. If the weight in your container is above what was included in your payment, we will charge you the overage. The overage is calculated at \$95 per ton, prorated accordingly. (Volume and weight go hand in hand with your debris)

- 10 YD includes 2 tons
- 12 YD includes 2.5 tons
- 15 YD includes 3 tons
- 20 YD includes 4 tons
- 30 YD includes 5 tons
- 40 YD includes 6 tons

There are several items that have an additional charges:

- Mattresses- \$10.00
- Refrigerators- \$20.00
- Air conditioners-\$20.00
- Tires (varies by size) and Propane Tanks (varies by size)

Protect your driveway:

If you are concerned about your driveway, please provide plywood. Our drivers are happy to put the container on the wood provided (*our drivers do not supply*). Please remember that the containers have metal rollers, therefore, it can leave a mark on the asphalt. Additionally, the dumpster gets heavier when loaded. Due to the weight and the higher temperatures in the summer, the asphalt is more prone to marks.
