NOTE: A \$25 Fee per game suspended will be applied towards the player being suspended.

Clarifications:

- 1- The player sent off for a double yellow card, for whatever reason, will serve a 1-match suspension.
- 2- The player sent off for a direct red card will serve a minimum of 1 game of sanction or more, depending on the cause expressed by the referee in the minutes, except in 3 very specific cases that do not give rise to interpretation (indicated below) in the who will NOT serve sanction:
- Cause 2; Case 1) Hand of the goalkeeper outside the area (it is expulsion but does not lead to suspension)
- Cause 2; Case 2) Avoid a goal with the hand (the goalkeeper is excepted); (it is expulsion but does not carry suspension)
- Cause 2; Case 3) Cut off a clear scoring opportunity with the hand (the goalkeeper is excepted); (it is expulsion but does not carry suspension)
- 3- "Incidents of the Sports Regulations" are understood to be non-violent game actions that by regulation are punished with expulsion from the playing field. Example: Minor foul against an opponent being the last defensive player aborting a clear scoring opportunity.
- 4- The accumulation of 3 yellow cards in the tournament means 1 game of sanction. The accumulation of 3 red cards in the tournament means expulsion from the tournament.
- 5- When a player is sent off for receiving 2 yellow cards in a match, he does not accumulate a yellow card.
- 6- When a player receives a yellow and a direct red in a match, he accumulates 1 yellow card and 1 red card.

- 7- The sanctions will be carried out on the next day to be played according to the calendar, regardless of the competition.
- 8- In no case will a precautionary sanction be applied, allowing a player to play a match.
- 9- The Board of Directors reserves the right to act ex officio, in the event of any circumstance that is not reflected by the referee in the minutes.

Rules and sanctions towards teams:

- 1- The team that fields a player who is not registered will lose the match by 0-10 and 6 points will be deducted.
- 2- If a team, without prior notice to the representatives, does not appear for a match, it will lose the match with the result of 0-3.
- 3- If a team informs the competition representatives of the league that it will not appear for a match 48 hours before the time of the match, it will lose the match with a score of 0-3 and will have to pay double arbitration before the next game can be scheduled, but will not be sanctioned if another team is available as a replacement.
- 4- The team that does not show up with a minimum of 7 players, including the goalkeeper, will be considered as not showing up and without warning, so they will lose the match with the result of 0-3 and will have to pay double arbitration before scheduling their game. next match. Only in this case will there be a maximum waiting time of 10 minutes from the scheduled start time of the match, before ending it due to "non-appearance".
- 5- Under no circumstances may a match start or continue if a team does not have at least 7 players on the field, including the goalkeeper. In the event that a team, during a match, is left with less than 7 players (including the goalkeeper) on the field, it will lose the match by the result of 3-0 or by the result that is occurring at that time. moment as long as it is greater and is in favor of the rival team. Once the match has started, both teams are responsible for paying their arbitration fees. 6- The team that voluntarily leaves the field before the end of a match will lose the match by the result of 0-3 or by the result it is giving at that moment as long as it is older and in favor of the rival team half a time. Both teams agree to end the game early. Once the match has started, both teams are responsible for paying their arbitration fees.
- 7- LGK Soccer reserves the right to act ex officio, in the event of any special circumstance or circumstance not provided for in these regulations and sanctioning code. Sanctions against a team can result in:
- a) The loss of matches.
- b) The loss of points.
- c) The elimination of a competition.
- d) Expulsion from the league.
