•**October 13th - 17th:** Advance Voting Period at the Aurora Seniors Centre, located at 90 John West Way. Residents will be able to vote using a paper ballot.

•**October 19, 2018:** Final day for an individual, corporation, or union to register with the Clerk's Office as a third party advertiser

•**October 22, 2018:** Voting Day. Most voting locations open at 10 a.m. and close at 8 p.m. There is **NO** Internet voting on Voting Day.
