## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat is a high-strength, premium, water-based, copolymer that provides added bond-strength, and is the perfect primer for BRICKFORM Stampable Overlay, Micro-Topping and SM Professional Grade. Because BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat re-emulsifies when wet, it is preferred over other acrylic primers for concrete resurfacing products. BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat can be used on any concrete surface.

## **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Surface must be clean and free of contaminants, old polishes must be removed, and the floor must be completely dry before application. New concrete should be cured for at least 14 days. The floor should be adequately profiled via mechanical or chemical means to ensure proper bonding.

## **APPLICATION**

BRICKFORM strongly recommends representative jobsite test sections. The surface of the concrete must be scarified or sandblasted and be completely free from all dirt, oil, paint, moss, dust, and other contaminates. After scarifying or sandblasting, power-wash the concrete surface. Remove any standing water, and allow the surface to partially dry before applying BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat.

To ensure bond-strength, BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat must be used on the concrete surface prior to applying BRICKFORM Stampable Overlay, Micro-Topping or SM Professional Grade. Apply full-strength, directly onto the concrete surface. Can be brushed on or rolled on using a short-napped roller. BRICKFORM Triple Seven Bond Coat can also be applied using a low-pressure, airless sprayer. Apply a thin coat; if surface is very porous, a second coat may be necessary. Overlay can be applied immediately after primer placement, no lengthy drying time needed. The primer remains reactive for two hours, if two or more hours elapse, re-spray primer over affected area and then place overlay.

### **STORAGE**

Product should NOT be stored in temperatures above 90°F. Keep containers tightly sealed DO NOT allow product to freeze. DO NOT store for more than one year.

# COVERAGE

One gallon of Triple Seven BOND COAT should cover 160 to 200 square feet per gallon (800 to 1200 square feet per 5 gallon bucket). Coverage will vary according to the porosity and composition of the floor material.
