RULES FOR LOT PLANTINGS, DECORATIONS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS

- No planting of any shrubs or trees shall be made without prior approval by the Board of Trustees.
- 2. No trees, shrubs or flowers, growing upon said lot shall be cut down or removed without the consent of the Superintendent.
- 3. The Superintendent shall have the right to remove from any lot: trees, shrubs, baskets, urns, flower boxes, pots, vases, wreaths or other forms of decoration, the retention of which in the Superintendent's judgment, are dangerous, inconvenient or detrimental to the appearance, condition or upkeep of the cemetery. Nothing in this provision shall be construed as an intention to assume any liability or obligation for any damages which may result from failure of this company to act.
- 4. No lot shall be enclosed by curbing, railings, and hedges or otherwise, without the approval of the Trustees.
- 5. No artificial decorations will be permitted from April 1st. to October 31st.
- 6. Seasonal decorations on shrubs, bushes or trees will not be permitted.
- One removable flower box or flower tub will be allowed on each gravesite. These receptacles are to be made of durable material. Glass containers of any kind are not acceptable.
- 8. Planting barriers are encouraged around monuments but must be approved by the Superintendent.
- The Superintendent without notice will remove articles such as shells, stones chips, mulch, glass
 receptacles, pictures, lights, wooden crosses, statues, emblems, wire or any other objects which may be
 considered unsafe or inappropriate.
- 10. No dogs are permitted on the cemetery grounds.
- 11. No person(s) shall be allowed to enter the cemetery for the purpose of mowing grass, cutting brush or any other maintenance work unless otherwise hired by the Superintendent.
