## SENIORS COACHES REPORT

Round 1 FOREST HILL 14-15-99 Defeated Surrey Park 9-9-63

The season got off to a terrific start with a comprehensive victory over Surrey Park. Michael Cardamone with 5 and Steven Pimm with 4 goals were the pick of the forwards, and it was pleasing to have Daniel Ousley, Steven Pimm, Luke Strachan all debut at the club in the opening round, Michael Cardamone was also returning to the club for his first game in green and white stripes since 2013.

Round 2 FOREST HILL 26-17-172 Defeated Nunawading 1-3-9

Anytime you hold an opposition to 1 goal for a game of senior football the team have performed well. This day was played in wet miserable conditions so our score of 26 goals was extremely pleasing. Steven Pimm was outstanding with his 9 goals, with 9 individual goal kickers and Pimmy was ably assisted by Michael Cardamone who chipped in with another 4 goals. So, after 2 rounds, the Zebras were on top of the Home and Away ladder on percentage.

Round 3 FOREST HILL 10-12-72 Lost To Glen Waverley Hawks 15-12-102

Round 3 saw the club lose our first game for the season. Leading at quarter time in a fiercely contested match the Hawks completely dominated the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter to kick 9 goals to our 1. This effately was the match, with a number of injuries to key players, we fought back hard and mid-way through the last quarter were less than 2 gaols behind. However, in the end a couple of late goals right at the end of the game extended Glen Waverley lead to the margin of 30 points.

Round 4 FOREST HILL 7-15-57 Lost to East Burwood 14-8-92

Same scoring shots at goal, yet a 35-point result, bad kicking is bad football. The Zebras and Rams played a hard contested first half, Forest Hill extremely waste full in front of goals. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, Forest Hill fell away for a 10-minute period and East Burwood capitalised and extended the lead on the score board. Michael Cardamone was the best forward booting 5 of the 7 goals scored on the day. So, 2 wins and 2 losses after the first month of football, not unfamiliar territory as in 2016 and 2017 the club was 2-2 in both seasons.

This week is a critical game against Coldstream, currently 2-2. The competition is so even this season, many sides of previous years that have perhaps struggled a bit on filed have improved significantly and no game is going to be an easy victory.

The upcoming month will dictate where the Zebras sit in terms of season 2018, R5 Coldstream (2-2) Home, R6 Whitehorse Pioneers (4-0) Away, R7 Silvan (1-3) Home, and R8 Fairpark (2-2) Home.

It would be terrific to see as many supporters as possible at all our home games cheering on the Zebs.
