Shoaff's Mill was built in the 1830s and was used to grind corn and animal feed until the 1940s. It was restored by the park and now operates on weekends and during special events. See a 32 foot steel waterwheel turn as it did over a hundred years ago as you step back in time to tour Shoaff's Mill

These are the entrances to the festival, whether you walk in or the shuttle bus drops you off. This is so you can orient yourself to the map.




