TRASH PICKUP

Dlease be advised of the trash pickup days in our community:

- City of Houston Garbage Pickup: Every Monday
- Recycling: Every other Monday
- Tree Waste Pickup 1st Monday of January, March, May, July, September and November
- Junk Waste: 1st Monday of February, April, June, August, October and December

Household trash must be placed inside the cityprovided container and placed at the curb no earlier than 6 p.m. the day before and 7 a.m. the day of collection. Containers must be placed out of public view. Violation of any provision of the solid waste ordinance is punishable upon first conviction by a fine of no less than \$250 nor more than \$2,000.

To report a violation or file a complaint, call 3-1-1. All Solid Waste Management Department Supervisors may issue citations.



kirkwoodcountry.com, to access an ACC form. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in immediate

removal and/or legal action being taken.

Residents should keep up with trimming trees, repairing fences and maintaining mailboxes. If replacing an entire fence, an ACC form must be completed and submitted prior to the work beginning.

PROHIBITED YARD PARKING ORDINANCE

The Board of Directors is pleased **L** to announce that the Prohibited Yard Parking Ordinance, Ordinance 2013-1132 was passed by Houston City Council on December 11, 2013, and is now in full force! All residents should be advised that parking any vehicle in your yard is a misdemeanor and violators will be fined not more than \$150.00 per day.

Vehicles and equipment refers to and includes any house trailer, mobile home, motor truck, passenger motor vehicle, motor home, camper cabin, motorcycle, trailer, boat, farm machinery or similar equipment or any truck with more than two (2) axles or any trailer, mobile home or motor home with a length exceeding 20 feet.

Please obey all speed limits in and around our neighborhood, and be especially careful when around schools, buses and children walking to an from school.
