Key Differences You Must Master

Advanced writers must adjust tone, structure, and purpose depending on whether they are writing academically or professionally. Use this checklist to choose the right approach.

Purpose

- Is the goal to analyse and explain ideas, or to inform and persuade a reader?
- Does the writing meet the expectations of the intended audience?

Tone & Style

- Is the tone objective and cautious (academic) or direct and practical (professional)?
- Have I avoided unnecessary complexity when clarity is required?

Structure

- Is the structure extended and formal, or concise and results-focused?
- Are headings and formatting used appropriately for the context?

Language Choice

- Have I selected precise vocabulary suitable for the context?
- Have I avoided informal or conversational language where it is inappropriate?
