  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF EXCEPTIONAL FAMILY** 

- 4 MEMBER PROGRAM ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- 5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Chapter 7 of title 10, United
  6 States Code, is amended by inserting before section 187
  7 the following new section 186:

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## 1 "§186. Exceptional Family Member Program Advi 2 sory Council

3 "(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is an Exceptional
4 Family Member Program Advisory Council in the Depart5 ment of Defense (in this section referred to as the 'Coun6 cil').

7 "(b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of the Council is to provide, to the Subcommittees on Military Personnel of 8 the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and 9 10 House of Representatives, the Secretary of Defense, and the chiefs of the covered armed forces, recommendations 11 regarding how to improve the Exceptional Family Member 12 13 Program. The Council shall provide such recommendations not less than once every six months. 14

- 15 "(c) COMPOSITION.—The Council shall be composed16 of the following:
- 17 "(1) One member of each covered armed18 force—
- 19 "(A) serving on active duty;
- 20 "(B) who has a dependent—
- 21 "(i) enrolled in the Exceptional Fam-
- 22 ily Member Program; and

23 "(ii) with an individualized education24 program; and

- 25 "(C) appointed by the Vice Chief of Staff
  - of the covered armed force concerned.

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1	"(2) Two military spouses—
2	"(A) of members eligible to be appointed
3	under paragraph (1);
4	"(B) who are not civilian employees of the
5	Department of Defense;
6	"(C) one of whom is married to an enlisted
7	member and one of whom is married to an offi-
8	cer; and
9	"(D) appointed by the Vice Chief of Staff
10	of the covered armed force concerned.
11	"(3) One adult dependent—
12	"(A) enrolled in the Exceptional Family
13	Member Program; and
14	"(B) appointed by the Vice Chief of Staff
15	of the covered armed force concerned.
16	"(4) One representative of the Exceptional
17	Family Member Program Coalition.
18	"(5) One member of the Defense Health Agen-
19	cy.
20	"(6) One member of the Department of De-
21	fense Education Activity.
22	"(7) One member of the Office of Special
23	Needs.
24	"(d) Appointments.—In making appointments
25	under subsection (c), the Vice Chief of Staff of the covered

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armed force concerned shall seek to represent the diversity
 of the disability community.

3 "(e) TERMS.—Each member of the Council shall
4 serve a term of two years, except one of the original mem5 bers appointed under subsection (c)(2), selected by the
6 Secretary of Defense at the time of appointment, one shall
7 be appointed for a term of three years.

8 "(f) MEETINGS.—The Council shall meet at least 9 once every calendar quarter, in person or by teleconfer-10 ence.

11 "(g) COVERED ARMED FORCE DEFINED.—In this
12 section, the term 'covered armed force' means an armed
13 force under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of a military
14 department.".

(b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
(1) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections

at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting before the item relating to section 187 the
following new item:

"186. Exceptional Family Member Program Advisory Council.".

(2) COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR MILITARY FAMILIES WITH
SPECIAL NEEDS.—Section 563 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010 (Public Law 111-84; 10 U.S.C. 1781c note) is amended
by striking subsection (d).
