- 2 July 2021: <u>Coalition Letter*</u> to Lt Gen Place
- 8 July 2021: <u>American Academy of Pediatrics Letter</u> to Lt Gen Place
- 9 July 2021: National Coalition for Access to Autism Services Letter to HASC and SASC
- 13 July 2021: <u>ABA Coding Coalition** Letter</u> to Lt Gen Place
- 13 Sept 2021: <u>Meeting Notes</u> with DHA, highlighted by, primary author of the PDDBI "**Dr. Cohen** concluded that the DHA reports to Congress reflected a lack of understanding of the PDDBI, and that selective elimination of a large portion of cases led to biased data and data analyses"
