





CHAPTER 1: EVERY MAN NEEDS A R.A.F.T.

If you are like me, you have gone to conferences, read articles and books seeking answers to this perpetual male dilemma. There has been no shortage of effort put into seeking to solve the "man problem." Allow me to share a few discoveries other great motivators of men have already made in efforts to get to the root of the matter:

- A tremendous mentor and spiritual influence in my life, Larry Titus of Kingdom Global Ministries, writes in his book, The Teleios Man that a man must discover his identity to become "teleios" or complete. Larry, I couldn't agree more!
- In his best-selling book," Wild at Heart, author John Eldridge gives men permission "to be men" and to rediscover their "masculine heart" without resorting to being the typical "Macho Man." That makes a lot of sense to me, John! Dr. Tony Evans, one of the country's most respected leaders in evangelical circles, also addresses the "man problem" in his book Kingdom Man. He writes that the world is falling apart, not due to the lack of males, but the lack of "Kingdom Men"—men who will align themselves with the comprehensive rule of God. Pastor Evans, your insight is profound as usual!
- The late Dr. Myles Munroe, in his book, Understanding the Power and Purpose of Men, also noted that men are in crisis of purpose due in part to their misunderstanding of their roles in society.
- Now, I could fill several pages with quotes from the late Edwin Louis Cole (father of the modern Men's Movement), former University of Colorado football Coach Bill McCartney of the Promise Keepers movement, or Bishop T.D. Jakes of ManPower and He-Motions fame.

Just thinking about their collective God-given insight on the subject makes me to want to go back and re-examine the ABC's of my own personal understanding of manhood.

Even with all their incredible insights on men, I believe there are still more truths that will help men effectively combat the tendency to spiral into abusive and destructive patterns and a life without purpose. And, as much as my understanding of "all things men" is still developing, I am compelled to share what God has given to me in this area. So, as I say, "Yes and Amen," to the great men that have gone before me, I want to re-present principles that address the man issue. All the guoted authors will agree that:

- · Every man has a God-given calling;
- · Every man has a God-ordained purpose.

But, today the issue before us is not what every man has. The issue before us is what every man NEEDS to walk out that calling and purpose. I submit to you that EVERY man NEEDS a R.A.F.T.

- If you are the custodian in the bathroom, the clerk in the mailroom, the attorney in the courtroom, or the CEO in the boardroom, you need a R.A.F.T.!
- If you live in the hood, the hills, the burbs, the barrio, the ghetto, or in a gated community, you absolutely need a R.A.F.T.!
- You may be nerdy, techie, trendy, messy, sloppy or a foodie. You need a R.A.F.T.!
- · You may be a creative artist, a recording artist, or a sandwich artist at the local Subway. You still need a R.A.F.T.!

The R.A.F.T. I am talking about is not a bright yellow flotation device (though that works, too!). It is a lifesaving device of sorts...and much more! In this book, you will discover that the R.A.F.T. I am speaking of has multiple purposes. It can be:

- · A craft to help you NEGOTIATE life's turbulent waters.
- A vehicle to TRANSPORT you to your God-ordained destination.
- A platform for developing meaningful CONNECTIONS with other men.
- A vessel that allows you to EXPERIENCE the ADVENTURE of a lifetime.
- · A system that enables you to SURVIVE floods of adversity.

The R.A.F.T. I am talking about is not the gift, purpose, or the calling, but a framework that is God-designed and enables you to walk in that purpose and calling with success.
