
## KEEPIN' WARM AT WINTER GET-TOGETHER



Our roving photographers Fred Goerlitz and Leo Maren report on still another professional car hidden in a first aid squad bay. This one's located in the hometown of Past President Mahlon Thompson, in Cranbury, NJ The car is a 1957 S&S Cadillac Profesional High Body and was the Cranbury First Aid Squad's first ambulance. It was delivered on September 12, 1957 by NJ S&S Distributor Harry Wagner, and was placed in service on October 27. The four-patient capacity ambulance is finished in Alpine White over Dakota Red, and shows 53,206 miles on its odometer.

The car is presently undergoing a complete restoration, with fresh paint and some interior work already completed. And to prove that these people who own this rare vehicle are serious (and sentimental) about their ambulance, there is even an Arlington green '57 Coupe DeVille parts car, garage-kept, of course! And, naturally, both local and national PCS membership applications were left with the Squad.


