Stallion Service Contract

I, _____ (mare owner), hereby agree on _____ (date) to contract with Kaylee Kapraun (stallion manager/2K) to breed the following mare,

Name: _____ Reg#: _____ Breed: _____ to the stallion, **WINE O** (AQHA# 6159471) for the 2027 breeding season (Feb. 5th to July 15th) subject to the following terms and conditions.

Booking and Stallion Fees

- Mare Owner agrees to return this contract with a non-refundable booking fee of **\$200** and a copy of Mare's registration papers to reserve a breeding for the year 2027, which shall be credited against the Stallion Service Fee.
- Stallion Fee is for one live foal. The balance of the Stallion Fee (**\$800**) is due when the mare departs from 2K Performance Horses, after insemination, or before the first cooled semen shipment.
- All other expenses are due according to the schedules below.
- Mare shall be healthy and in sound breeding condition.

For Cooled Semen Shipments:

- CONTRACTS MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED, AND PAID IN FULL AT LEAST 3 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO ORDERING SEMEN.
- Includes collection/evaluation costs. Shipping charges are separate: \$75 on-site pickup, \$350 FedEx, \$400 air freight (includes courier). Shipments to Canada incur a \$500 fee.
- The mare must be placed on the collection list by 5:00 PM Central Time the day before collection and must confirm or cancel by 8:00 AM Central Time on the day of planned collection. Orders must be placed by calling/texting **(309) 635-2324** (NO EMAILS!). Calls on collection morning may not guarantee receipt of semen that day.
- Shipping container must be returned within 48 hours or replacement fees will apply.
- 2K guarantees that semen will be viable when it leaves our facility. Once shipped, 2K is not responsible for any loss of quality, contamination, shipping delays, or failure to achieve pregnancy. Semen must be inseminated within 24 hours of collection.
- Mares on the farm at 2K have breeding priority; cooled semen availability is not guaranteed for specific days.
- Mare Owner agrees to keep a valid credit card on file for charging all shipment-related fees. This card will be charged automatically as shipments are ordered throughout the year unless Mare Owner sends a check prior to the shipment
- Semen provided under this contract may only be used for the mare named in the agreement unless otherwise authorized in writing by stallion manager.
- The above stated fees are subject to change at the discretion of Kaylee Kapraun and 2K Performance Horses.

On Site Breeding, Mare Care and Board

- Mare Owner must provide a current negative Coggins test and health records for out-of-state mares. If not provided, 2K's veterinarian will test/examine at Mare Owner's expense.
- Mare care & Board: \$15/day for pasture mares, \$25/day for stalled mares. Veterinary care is at Mare Owner's expense. Foal at side fee, \$5/day. (If the foal at side is sired by Wine O, they stay free of charge.)
- 2K will attempt to settle the mare; if unsuccessful, Mare can be returned in the same breeding season for no additional fees excluding mare care. Following year rebreeds will be charged \$200 booking fee.
- 2K is not liable for any accident, injury, sickness, or death to the mare/foal. Mare Owner is not liable for injury or death to the stallion.
- Mare Owner must pay 2K's veterinarian directly for any services not billed by 2K.

Mare owner understands and complies with the following: This contract contains a **Live Foal Guarantee** for the initial contract year when the mare has been pregnancy checked and declared to be safe in foal by a veterinarian. A live foal is described as a newborn foal that stands and nurses without assistance. If the mare miscarries, aborts, or the foal is born dead, Mare Owner agrees to furnish 2K, within ten (10) days, a veterinarian's statement describing the occurrence, in such a case, return privileges will be available for the following year. If the mare dies or becomes unfit to breed, the Mare Owner may return during this season or the following season **ONLY** with a suitable mare approved by the Stallion Manager. For mares returning the following season for a rebreed that have paid the stallion fee, \$800 will carry over. Rebreds and donated breeding's are subject to a \$200 booking fee for the next years breeding season. Failure to return the mare for breeding the following year, then all fees paid shall be forfeited, the right to rebreed is cancelled and the Stallion Owner is released from all further obligations of the contract, unless otherwise agreed in writing and signed by all parties. Sale of the mare by Mare Owner to another party will terminate the live foal guarantee. Breeding fee(s) will not be refunded. Stallion Manager and Stallion Owner do not make any warranty or representation as to the quality or confirmation of the foal, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, or that the foal will be free of any deformity, conformation defect, disease or inherited trait In the event of the death of the above-named stallion, this contract shall become null and void. No money shall be refunded to mare owner except the booking fee if the mare has not been bred. In the event of the stallion's death prior to the delivery of a live foal, the live foal guarantee as above described shall become null and void. Mare Owner agrees to inform Stallion Manager of the resulting **pregnancy status** in writing by August 1st of this contract breeding year. Mare Owner is responsible for a \$100.00 late fee per association report, should any breeding report be amended. To obtain a Breeders Certificate, you must notify Kaylee Kapaun of the birth of foal. This certificate will not be issued nor released until the account has been paid in full. There will be no exceptions to the terms of this contract, and it is not transferable unless provided for in writing and signed by all parties.

The parties hereby specifically agree that this Agreement shall be construed, governed and interpreted by and in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Iowa. In any action or arbitration is brought to enforce or interpret the terms of this Agreement, the proper place of venue shall be Marshalltown, Iowa as this agreement shall be performed in Marshall County, Iowa as the last act to make this a binding contract. Should any civil action by commenced between the parties concerning this Agreement, or any rights or duties hereunder, the prevailing party shall be entitled, in addition to any other relief as may be granted, to reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements as determined by a court or competent jurisdiction. If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unenforceable or void, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall be nevertheless continue in full force and effect without being impaired or invalidated in any way except the parties agree to insert, to the extent possible, a substitute provision to carry out the intention of the parties.

On Site Mares

Mare owner understands and complies with the following:

1. All mare care charges, including any charges of horseshoeing, veterinary care, or similar charges shall be due and payable prior to the return of mare to Mare Owner.
2. Mare Owner hereby states they have inspected the premises of the breeding facility, including the facilities in which the mare is to be kept and is satisfied with their condition, upkeep and safety. Mare Owner agrees that the standard of care to be imposed upon Farm is that of ordinary care of a prudent horse owner.
3. Mare Owner acknowledges that maintaining current vaccinations is the Mare Owners' sole responsibility. While the Farm may recommend certain vaccinations, the Farm does not guarantee or warrant the health of any horse on the premises. Mare Owner assumes all risks associated with that decision including but not limited to the risk of illness, disease or death resulting from the exposure to infectious or contagious diseases. The mare Owner agrees the Farm, its owner's employees and agents shall not be held liable for any illness, loss or damages arising from or related to the Mare owner's vaccination decisions.
4. Mare Owner understands and agrees that prior to arrival at the breeding facility, it is recommended the mare will be cultured and examined by a licensed veterinarian approved by Farm, at Mare Owner's expense.
5. Mare Owner authorizes Farm, to engage performance of such other veterinary services as Farm may deem necessary for the proper treatment, care and protection of the mare and/or foal at side. This is to be done at the Mare Owner's expense and will be billed and payable as above-described.
6. In the event of colic or life-threatening illness of the mare, all means available will be utilized to save said mare unless otherwise instructed by Mare Owner, including surgery, transporting mare (additional fee for milage) if recommended by the veterinarian. Mare Owner shall pay all costs in connection therewith.
7. Farm shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, estray, theft, death, or injury which may be suffered by the mare and/or foal at side, or any other cause of action whatsoever arising out of or connected in any way with the breeding or boarding of the mare and/or foal. This includes, but is not limited to, any personal injury or disability which the Mare Owner or Owners may receive while on the premises of the breeding facility.
8. Mare Owner fully understands that Farm does not carry any outside horses in its possession, custody or control for breeding and boarding on any public liability, accidental injury, theft or equine mortality insurance, and that all risks connected with the breeding and boarding of the mare or mares and/or foals are to be born by the Mare Owner or Owners.
9. Farm strongly recommends equine mortality insurance be obtained applicable to the subject horse(s) by Owner.
10. Mares that are not halter broke and/or cannot be hobbled will not be accepted. Mare Owner further authorizes breeding by artificial insemination if deemed reasonable or necessary by Stallion Manager and agrees to pay any veterinary charges arising in connection therewith.

11. In the event Mare Owner does not leave the mare at the breeding facility for 16 days following last breeding for purposes of pregnancy ultrasound, Mare owner assumes all responsibility for having mare confirmed in foal.
12. Owner agrees to submit a completed Horse Information Sheet at least five days prior to the mare's arrival on the premises of the breeding facility.

Inherent Risks and Assumption of Risk.

The undersigned acknowledges there are inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below, and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in ways such as, running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability.
